I am writing with information concerning the continuation of your Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) Law Enforcement/Prosecutor Based Victim Assistance grants. At the next Budget Committee meeting staff will recommend a continuation designation for your VOCA funded program. In order to assist you in beginning the continuation process prior to the Budget Committee approval, I have attached the Uniformed Application for Grant Assistance form, the Program Narrative, the Uniformed Budget template, and other required documents so you can begin the continuation material process. This designation will be for a 18-month grant period.

Please use the unofficial Federal designated amount of \$230,895 for continuation of this program. This designation requires a local matching contribution of \$57,724. This designation will not be official until the approval of the Budget Committee at next meeting and ICJIA Board approval.

This will be the final year of funding for this program under the current funding plan, and that once the planning process has been competed a new series of competitive bids will be developed for program priorities as established through the planning process. Please plan for the future of your program accordingly.
