Joint resolution approving an emergency appropriation of \$2,000,000 for Fiscal Year 2025 accepting funding from the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity (DCEO) Urban Shelter Program.

- The Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity (DCEO) made \$15,000,000 available to support construction, reconstruction, rehabilitation, or acquisition of property for homeless shelters.
- Lake County was awarded \$2,000,000 of Community Development Block Grant Corona Virus (CDBG-CV) funds from the Illinois DCEO.
- Funding will be subawarded to PADS Lake County to support the renovation of a former hotel into a fixed-site shelter serving homeless families.
