

Broadband Breakthrough Community Survey Results





- 84% of survey respondents reported having a wired internet connection
- 16% of survey reported they have no wired internet connection
 - 15% of Homes
 - 24% of businesses
 - 100% of farms/ag
- 30% reported having a cellular internet connection as their primary source of internet



Broadband Breakthrough Community Survey Results





63% of Internet Service Providers (ISP) promised residents 100 Mbps service (100/25 defined as "served") or faster

% Unfavorable ISP Ratings from Survey

Affordability: 72%

Speed: 40%

Reliability: 41%

Respondents Current Use of the Internet

Access government information	89%
Cloud-based services (Dropbox, iCloud, etc.)	75%
Communication (emails, video calls, social media)	100%
Education (K-12, higher education)	38%
Workforce training (online certifications)	45%
Entertainment (video/music streaming; gaming)	83%
Healthcare information and services	82%
Operate a home-based business	19%
Smart devices / surveillance / security	63%
Telecommute / Remote work	48%
Online banking and financial management	85%
Shopping (includes grocery)	88%


