Short Sale Policy - Owner Occupied Housing

Joel Williams, Community Development, presented a written policy for "Short Sale" of Owner and Non-Owner Occupied Housing – Homebuyer Assistance & Housing Rehabilitation. Short Sales typically occur when a borrower cannot pay their mortgage and the lender agrees to allow the sale of the home at a loss and helps to avoid foreclosure. The policy will increase the likelihood that Lake County can recapture at least a portion of previously awarded funds for future program use. An important consideration in these situations is the effect of the short sale or foreclosure on the current tenants of the property, who are not in any way responsible for the situation the borrower faces. Mr. Williams presented two policies - one for owner occupied housing

(homeownership) and one for non owner occupied (rental).
