Dear Ms. Trigg:

This spring the Illinois General Assembly introduced legislation under HB3794 that was ultimately signed into law by Governor Quinn on July 22, 2014 and termed the 2014 Capital Bill. This legislation included a \$100 million distribution of funds to local public agencies to mirror their annual receipts under the Illinois Jobs Now! Capital Bill program enacted in 2009.

The Illinois Jobs Now! annual distributions were made to local public agencies based on their motor fuel tax distribution eligibility in 2009. Changes to the motor fuel tax distribution law in July 2011 increased the number of eligible townships for motor fuel tax distributions.

The Department of Transportation, in cooperation with the Township Officials of Illinois, has determined there are six additional townships in Lake County eligible for the 2014 Capital Bill distribution. The attached Local Agency Agreement should be utilized to facilitate the transfer of funds from the Department of Transportation to the appropriate eligible township's motor fuel tax account. Please notify the appropriate officials from the list of eligible townships with information regarding this additional motor fuel tax supplement.
