

# AARON LAWLOR BIOGRAPHY

Aaron Lawlor was elected chairman of the Lake County Board in December of 2012 at the age of 30, becoming the youngest Board Chairman in the history of Lake County.

Aaron has served on the County Board since 2009 and is currently in his third term representing District 18 which includes all of Vernon Hills and Indian Creek as well as portions of Hawthorn Woods, Long Grove, Mundelein and unincorporated Lake County.

As Chairman, Aaron is working tirelessly to promote economic development, invest in transportation infrastructure and enact new measures to make government more accountable.

In 2014, Aaron was recognized by NBC's Chuck Todd as one of six "Rising Stars" in Illinois politics.

Prior to joining the County Board, Aaron served in senior positions with Senator Mark Kirk and Comptroller Judy Baar Topinka. He was recognized as one of 40 emerging leaders selected from across the state for the inaugural class of the Governor Jim Edgar Fellows Program in 2012.

Aaron is a lifelong resident of Vernon Hills and a graduate of Libertyville High School. He holds a Bachelors of Arts from Lake Forest College and a Masters in Business Administration from the Lake Forest Graduate School of Management.
