

**Please briefly describe the proposed scope of work in the space provided below:**

Nicasa has been providing problem gambling outreach and intervention services since 2002 and continues to be the only state-contracted agency in Lake County. Nicasa's gambling outreach, education, and assessment services are imperative to combat this hidden addiction. These funds will be used to educate Lake County residents on the effects of problem gambling via free, bilingual trainings, workshops, printed and digital materials, as well as to provide free consultations to affected individuals and/or their family members. While it is important to educate everyone, the target population will focus on the youth, senior citizens, young men, athletes (youth and adults), people experiencing domestic violence, first responders (particularly police), and populations of color. For the past 6 years employees have presented to numerous groups and educated more than 7,000 youth and adults to educate them on the signs, symptoms, and risks associated with problem gambling. Outreach efforts and presentations have included a range of group types and venues, including school assemblies, rotary and exchange clubs, police crisis intervention training sessions, parent nights, senior citizens groups, local nonprofits, local colleges/universities, faith-based/religious groups, village boards and townships, video gaming businesses, criminal justice groups, job fairs, health and wellness fairs, hospitals, libraries, corporations, the Lake County Health Department, and more. This program offers both in-person and virtual options for outreach and education (which is determined by the preference of the group seeking information).

Nicasa has 1,265 followers on Facebook, 594 on Instagram, 529 on X.
