I am pleased to inform you that the Site Selection & Monitoring Committee of the Adult Redeploy Illinois Oversight Board has approved a funding award up to the \$92,787 requested by Lake County. Funds are approved for EPICS (Effective Practices In Community Supervision) training for probation staff and residential treatment for high-risk offenders. In keeping with the goals of Adult Redeploy Illinois, treatment funds are limited to offenders who face prison time if this treatment were not available. The Committee also requests that Lake County develop a plan to implement a local Adult Redeploy Illinois program in the coming year.

If you agree to these terms, we will begin the paperwork using the documentation already submitted by your office. The start date of the grant agreement will be February 1, 2013. Funds will be available upon execution of a grant agreement between your office and the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority.
