PY06 Out of School Youth Results Lake County Workforce Development Department

Five Contractors entered into agreements with the Lake County Workforce Development Department on February 5th 2007 to offer 9 months of program services to the Youth of Lake County ages 19-21 with an additional year of follow up services. The services offered vary from vocational training, college coursework, basic skill enhancement, work readiness curriculum, job shadow experiences, work experiences and assistance with finding gainful employment or enrollment into post secondary school.
