## 7.2 25-1579

Approval of the Stormwater Infrastructure Repair Fund (SIRF) Eligibility Authorization for the Village of Bannockburn Storm Sewer Project.

- The project involves installing 310 linear feet of storm pipe to improve drainage in a
  persistently flooded area in the Bannockburn Court neighborhood. The proposed
  project includes performing earth excavation, laying new storm drainage pipe
  ranging from 15" to 36" in size, and restoring the disturbed area with topsoil and
  native plantings.
- The proposed project will help manage runoff more effectively, reducing the risk of structural damage and protecting both private property and overall water quality in the surrounding area.
- The estimated project cost is \$154,137.50.
- Approval of the Eligibility Authorization does not obligate funds. Staff will work with the project applicant to develop a Project Agreement and recommended funding.

#### 7.3 25-1580

Approval of the Stormwater Infrastructure Repair Fund (SIRF) Eligibility Authorization for the Village of Mundelein Wellington Avenue Stormwater Management Improvements Project.

- The proposed project involves installing 0.35 acre-feet of detention at 101
  Wellington Avenue, 250 feet of 12-inch storm sewer, and three storm sewer
  structures.
- The proposed project will relieve structural flooding impacts at 31 and 102 Wellington Avenue, reduce road flooding, and reduce nuisance flooding.
- The estimated project cost is \$133,000
- Approval of the Eligibility Authorization does not obligate funds. Staff will work with the project applicant to develop a Project Agreement and recommended funding.

#### 7.4 25-1589

Approval of the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) application for the update of the Multi-jurisdictional All-Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan (ANHMP).

- The current multi-jurisdictional ANHMP will expire on July 4, 2028, and must be updated and adopted by all participating jurisdictions to maintain Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) eligibility for non-disaster hazard mitigation funding.
- SMC staff coordinated with the Illinois Emergency Management Agency (IEMA) to identify funding and to submit an HMGP application to fund a significant update to the ANHMP.
- Approval is requested to acknowledge and approve the submission and authorize SMC staff to complete all follow-up actions required by IEMA/FEMA.
- Total project cost is \$130,000.00; HMGP provides 75% funding (\$99,038.77) and the 25% (\$30,961.23) non-federal share will be met through SMC staff time/in-kind services. SMC staff will manage and administer the grant and will be reimbursed \$6,155.09 in management costs.
- If awarded, SMC will initiate procurement of consultant services for technical analysis and begin coordination with the Hazard Mitigation Planning Committee (HMPC).
