maintenance responsibilities for a minimum of sixty (60) days or until second cutting, whichever is longer. Maintenance shall include watering, weeding, re-seeding (wash-offs) and other operations necessary to keep lawn in a thriving condition. Upon final acceptance, owner shall assume all maintenance responsibilities. After lawn areas have germinated, areas which fail to show a uniform stand of grass for any reason whatsoever shall be re-seeded repeatedly until all areas are covered with a satisfactory stand of grass. Minimum acceptance of seeded lawn areas may include scattered bare or dead spots, none of which are larger than one (1) square foot and when combined do not exceed 2% of total lawn area.

17. All seeded turf areas shall be fertilized at installation with 6-20-20 analysis, at a rate of 6 lbs. per 1,000 s.f.. A second application of 21-7-14 to be applied at rate of 6 lbs. per 1,000 s.f. after the first cutting. Acceptance and quarantee notes shall apply to all seeded areas.
