## **CHAIR'S REMARKS**

Please find my Chairman's Report for February 12 – March 12. As always, I look forward to your feedback on any of my activities. Today marks our first 100 days in this term. I have really enjoyed serving with each of you and appreciate the commitment all of our board members bring to public service.

## Community Forums:

We have conducted three of our five community forums as a part of our strategic planning process. It has been a great opportunity to meet with Lake County residents and hear their ideas on our strategic goals. We have two more forums planned. The next one is tonight at the Health Department on Grand Avenue in Waukegan. And our final forum is tomorrow night at Lakewood Forest Preserve in Wauconda. Both events begin with an open house at 6 PM and the community forum at 7 PM.

## Legislator Update / Meetings:

Two of our state legislative priorities were recently passed out of house committees. The first bill is HB 163 which gives Lake County more authority in cell tower siting. The second is HB 1020 which gives us the authority to expedite the demolition and removal of unsafe accessory structures such as garages and sheds. Currently we only have the authority to remove unsafe primary structures such as houses.

Late last month, Ryan Waller and I were in Springfield to meet with our House legislative delegation. We used the opportunity to update them Lake County's consensus transportation plan. Over the next few months, our DOT staff will be working to prioritize existing projects identified in the plan and providing an update.

## Metro Counties Board of Directors:

Yesterday I attended the Metro Counties Board of Directors meeting. Key topics included the 911 surcharge, probation funding, pensions, impact of managed care organizations on county-owned nursing homes, juvenile justice legislation and potential cuts to the Local Government Distributive Fund. I was also selected as the Chair of the Legislative Committee.

## CMAP County Board Chairs Meeting:

Earlier this month I attended our quarterly suburban county board chairs meeting hosted by CMAP. The main point of discussion was advocating for a performance-based criteria for distribution of IDOT funding. Funds are currently distributed based on a 55/45 split with downstate areas receiving 55% of funding and the Cook/Collar Counties receiving 45%.

Rosalind Franklin Medical School Meeting and Tour:

On February 14, HCS Chair Carlson and I toured Rosalind Franklin Medical School and met with President Michael Welch to discuss his health care jobs initiative, new initiatives at the school and opportunities for additional collaboration.

- Improve marketing efforts for business retention and attraction

Lake County Partners realizes that it needs to continue to improve its marketing materials to aggressively attract new jobs and investment to Lake County.

Partners is currently updating its marketing strategy to better position and promote the organization as the business location resource for Lake County, making target audiences aware of the professional economic development services provided which includes site location, demographic analysis, SBA loans, and information on state and local incentive programming.
