Subject: 2024 Bid Exemption for MCP

Good afternoon, RuthAnne

The Executive Steering Committee for the Integrated Case Management System (“ICMS”) are requesting a bid exemption under County Ordinance Sec. 33.066 to enter into a contract with Mission Critical Partners (“MCP”).

Going back several years, the County's Justice Partners—the State's Attorney, Public Defender, Courts, and Circuit Clerk—have employed MCP as a consultant on the ICMS Project. MCP has handled all project management tasks during implementation, and has more recently provided post-implementation support as well. The company has both detailed knowledge of the court-IT industry generally, and also has specific and unique knowledge about the intricacies of the County's ICMS implementation.

The bid exemption is premised on MCP's long-standing, successful relationship with the Justice Partners in providing consulting services on the ICMS project. Having been intimately involved in the ICMS implementation, MCP's knowledge provides value that no other consultant would be able to provide in the timeframe anticipated for this extension.
