**ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH FEES SCHEDULE** 

All fees will be increased annually based on the Lake County Consumer Price Index.

Any fee in this ordinance may be waived or reduced by the Health Officer based on hardship, for public health reasons, or to commemorate public health awareness events/celebrations.

## Late Fees for Food Service, Retail Food, or Non-Community Permits and Annual Licenses for ISD Contractor, Designer, Pumper or Soil Scientist

A twenty-five percent (25%) late fee will be charged to the above listed permit/license holders who do not pay their annual fee by February 1.

#### **Permit Fees for Food Service Establishments**

New food service establishments, retail food establishments and vending machine permits opening six (6) months or more after the permit due date will be assessed 50% of the appropriate fee.

#### Temporary Event Permit Late Fee

A late fee will be charged when a For Profit Vendor has not applied and paid for a permit a minimum of seven (7) days prior to the event.
