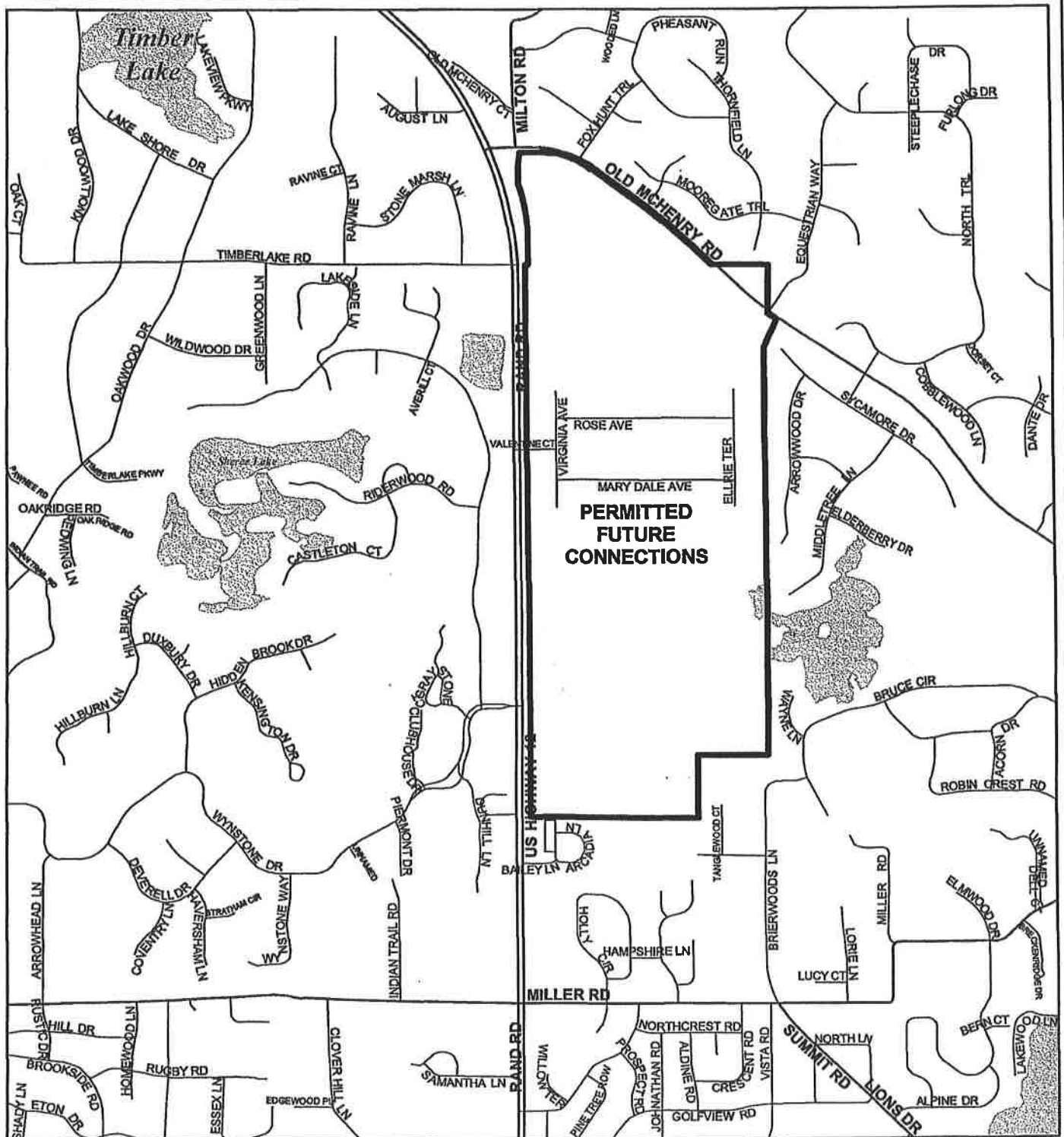

1	Public Works and Transportation Committee	04/08/2009	<b>Action Text:</b> This matter was presented <b>Notes:</b> Peter Kolb distributed maps of the area detailing the proposed Wynstone Pumping Station and the proposed connection to Lake Zurich Sewerage Collection System and advised that this would include 230 houses that will discharge 100,000 gallons per day into the system. County Administrator Barry Burton advised that they will pay a connection fee and a monthly bill. Mr. Kolb noted that North Barrington will own and operate this system. Discussion followed on this and the DeMucci system (Taubman Mall property)  Discussion followed and Member Maine felt that we should reach out to new mayors. Chair O'Kelly felt we should invite the new mayors here and give them information about County functions. Mr. Burton agreed that we need to get better relations with mayors. Chair O'Kelly suggested that we invite municipal and townships so that we can be working together. No action was taken on this item; it was a review of the draft agreement.
