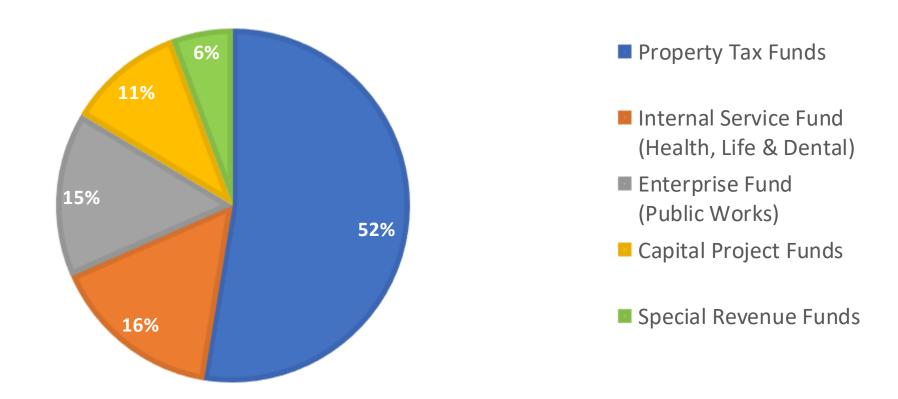

April 2023 Revenues

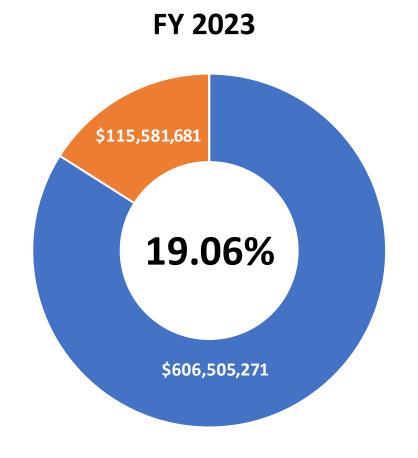


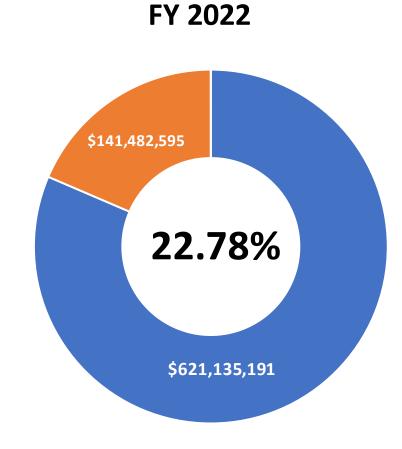
YTD REVENUES \$115,581,681



April 2023 Revenues





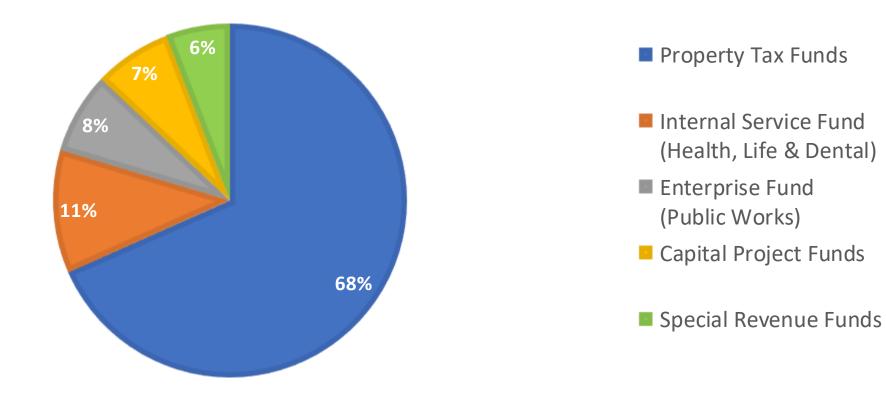

April 2023 Expenses

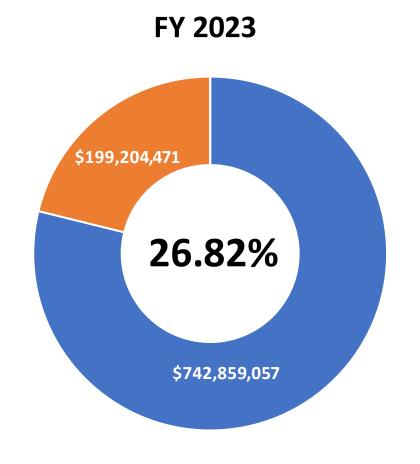


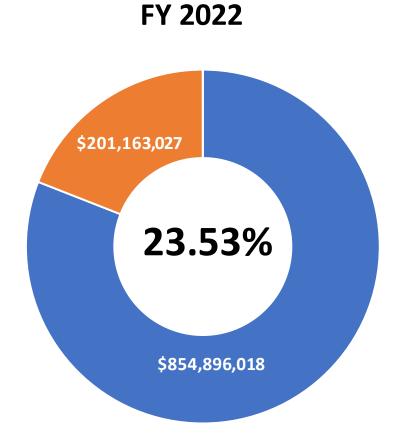
YTD EXPENSES \$199,204,471

Economic Indicators1/4% Sales Tax

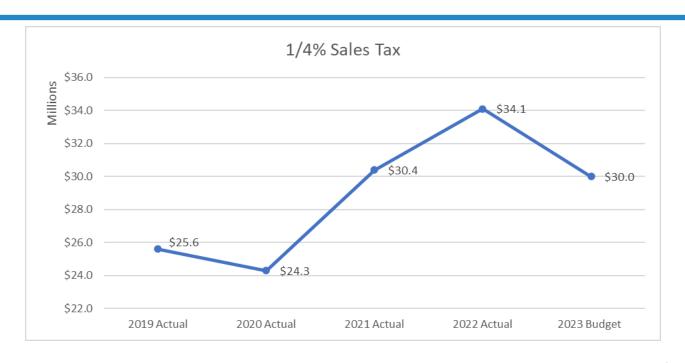


1/4% Sales Tax

- 1/4% Sales Tax is collected on all general merchandise purchased anywhere in Lake County.
- Impacts This revenue stream is sensitive to economic conditions.
- Provides a snapshot of COVID-19 recovery and improvement in local economic activity.
- The 1/4% Sales Tax accounts for approximately 23% of the Sales and Other Sales Tax revenue category.

Economic Indicators1/4% Sales Tax





- The 1/4% Sales Tax FY 2022 Actual Data (Unaudited) is \$34.1 million or 21% above budget.
- The 1/4% Sales Tax FY 2023 is \$8.1 million year-to-date and is currently 18% above budget.

Economic Indicators 1% Sales Tax

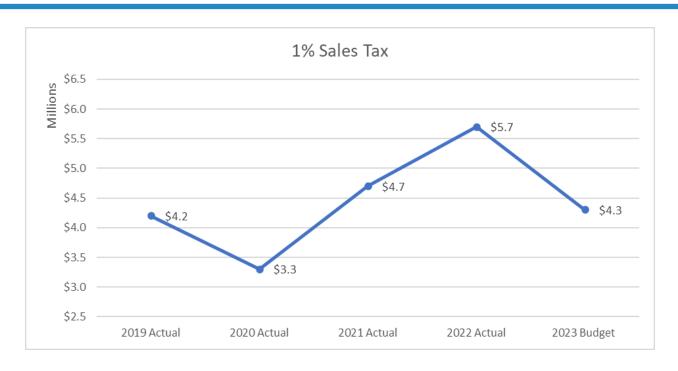


1% Sales Tax

- 1% Sales Tax is collected on general merchandise and qualifying food, drug, and medical appliances purchased in the unincorporated areas of Lake County.
- Impacts This revenue stream is sensitive to economic conditions and changes in unincorporated areas (for example, annexations).
- Provides a snapshot of COVID-19 recovery and improvement in local economic activity.
- The 1% Sales Tax accounts for approximately 3.3% of the Sales and Other Sales Tax revenue category.

Economic Indicators 1% Sales Tax





- The 1% Sales Tax FY 2022 Actual Data (Unaudited) is \$5.7 million or 33% above budget.
- The 1% Sales Tax FY 2023 is \$1.1 million year-to-date and is currently 24% above budget.

Economic Indicators - Review through April 30,2023



What does the Seasonalized Budget Expectation Column represent?

- Average historical, monthly actuals in relation to the current year's budget for revenue or expense line items.
- The Seasonalized Budget Expectation is presented year-to-date and for each month.

Economic Indicators - Review through April 30,2023



In the Monthly Report, there are two Economic Indicator Reports. What is the difference between the Year-To-Date Report and the Monthly Report?

- The Year-To-Date Report presents the actual revenue received and the actual expenditures spent from December 1 to April 30, 2023, in comparison to the <u>expected</u> revenue and expenditures for that time period.
- The Monthly Report presents the actual revenue received and the actual expenditures spend for the month of April 2023 and compares it to the <u>expected</u> revenue and expenditure for that month.

Utility Costs (Funds 101-220)	Apr-23	3,445,252	1,176,036	1,243,149	5.7%

- Based off historical data, we would expect Utility Costs YTD to be approximately \$1,176,036.
- Actual Utility Costs YTD is \$1,243,149.
- Our actual utility costs is 5.7% over our expected cost as of April 30, 2023.
