<u>2011 Events:</u> The RPC reviewed the "Promoting Sustainable Building and Development Practices in Lake County" report and the Model Ordinances for Solar and Geothermal Energy Systems.

After extensive review by the RPC, the ZBA and PB&Z Committee, the Lake County Board passed the amendment to the UDO to allow for permitting of wind energy facilities in March 2011.

PB&D staff applied for and was awarded Local Technical Assistance to update the Regional Framework Plan with a Sustainability Plan Chapter. See more details below.





Upcoming Topics in 2012: The RPC will begin its work with CMAP to update the Regional Framework Plan with the development of a Sustainability Chapter.
