#### 7.1 12-0308

Joint resolution authorizing Treasurer Robert Skidmore to withdraw monies from the Bond Series A of 2010 Construction Account to pay construction cost Items.

- The County issued bonds in October 2010 in the amount of \$20,000,000 to construct various water and sewer system improvements.
- Pursuant to the County Bond Ordinance, the County Board must approve disbursements of bond proceeds within the construction account.
- This withdrawal represents Payout No. 17 and pays several invoices related to various projects in the total amount of \$820,619.23.
- The remaining balance available, after authorization of this payment, will be \$3,267,676.

#### 7.4 12-0321

Joint resolution authorizing a contract for resurfacing portions of Lewis Avenue and Kenosha Road to Peter Baker and Son Company, Lake Bluff, Illinois in the amount of \$3,165,980.56 and designated as Section 11-00999-17-RS.

- Lewis Avenue and Kenosha Road Resurfacing: Contract Award.
- These resurfacing improvements have been identified within the County's pavement management system and are included in the 2012 program.
- A total of three bids were received, ranging from \$3,165,980 to \$3,996,923, with the Peter Baker and Son Company, Lake Bluff, Illinois being the lowest responsible bidder with a contract amount of \$3,165,980.56.

## 7.5 <u>12-0320</u>

Joint resolution appropriating \$1,250,000 of Motor Fuel Tax funds for the supply of ice control salt materials needed for the 2012-2013 winter season and designated as Section 13-00000-00-GM.

- Ice Control Salt 2012-2013 Winter Season: Appropriation.
- The Division of Transportation (DOT) annually appropriates funds for the procurement of ice control salt.
- DOT's contract for salt for the 2011-2012 winter season, which was provided by the State of Illinois Department of Central Management Services, will be extended for the winter season of 2012-2013.
- This resolution appropriates \$1,250,000 of Motor Fuel Tax funds for this purchase.

- These projects and revenue were not included in the FY 2012 budget.
- Without this action, these projects and revenue will not have the budget authority required.

#### 7.7 12-0337

Joint resolution authorizing an emergency appropriation of \$87,159.83 for interest earned and \$118,934.95 for the premium on the sale of bonds in the FY 2012 2010A Road Construction Bond fund for road improvements to public roads within the County, and designated as Section 10-00999-15-GB.

- <u>Lake County 2010A Road Construction Bond Fund: Emergency Appropriation.</u>
- The Lake County Board, at its meeting of August 10, 2010, approved the issuance of General Obligation Bonds (Sales Tax Alternate Revenue Source) with an interest

- rebate from the federal government.
- The Lake County Board, at its meeting of January 11, 2011, appropriated \$31,410,000 to the Road Construction Bond fund.
- This resolution appropriates \$87,159.83 of interest earned and \$118,934.95 for the premium on the sale of bonds to the FY 2012 2010A Road Construction Bond fund budget.

#### 7.8 12-0338

Joint resolution authorizing an emergency appropriation of \$18,163.39 for interest earned in the FY 2012 2011A Road Construction Bond fund for road improvements to public roads within the County, and designated as Section 11-00999-19-GB.

- Lake County 2011A Road Construction Bond Fund: Emergency Appropriation.
- The Lake County Board, at its meeting of March 15, 2011, approved the issuance of General Obligation Bonds (Sales Tax Alternate Revenue Source).
- The Lake County Board, at its meeting of June 14, 2011, appropriated \$21,815,896.70 to the Road Construction Bond fund.
- This resolution appropriates \$18,163.39 for interest earned to the FY 2012 2011A Road Construction Bond fund budget.

#### 7.9 12-0334

Joint resolution authorizing the execution of an agreement for consulting services with Victor S. Teglasi of Scarsdale, New York at a cost of \$158,840 to upgrade the current Lake County Division of Transportation's (LCDOT) licensed Capital Program Management System (CPMS), appropriating \$175,000 of Matching Tax funds for these services, and designating as Section 12-00000-11-EG.

- CPMS Upgrade Consultant Agreement and Appropriation.
- LCDOT is a licensed user of CPMS since 1990.
- CPMS is used extensively for a combined source of data in managing key documents, including: the County's five-year program, the County's annual program, IDOT motor fuel tax (MFT) reports, and the LCDOT bonding program.
- CPMS Windows-based version needs to be upgraded to SQL for a more modern and robust environment.
- This resolution authorizes a consulting agreement for these services, and appropriates \$175,000 of Matching Tax funds designated as Section 12-00000-11-EG.
