Resolution authorizing a funding application to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) Pathways to Removing Obstacles to Housing (PRO Housing) funding and authorizing execution of all necessary Memoranda of Understanding (MOU) and correspondence.

- HUD has made \$85 million available through the PRO Housing funding competition for communities or regions to identify and remove barriers to affordable housing production.
- The Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning (CMAP) is preparing an application for the Chicago region to address the issues regionally and increase the likelihood of being selected in the funding competition.
