9. County Administrator's Report

Sr. Assistant County Administrator Amy McEwan presented information for the new committee members on the various groups and committees under the jurisdiction of the Law and Judicial Committee. Ms. McEwan advised that she would add the new members to the mailing lists. State's Attorney Waller stated that the different coalitions and councils were a great asset to the criminal justice system. State's Attorney Waller touched on the Drug Court efforts and Mental Health Court. Ms. McEwan noted that Integrated Justice has been an ongoing project since 2001. This is an effort to bring integrated computer systems to all judicial agencies. Ms. McEwan highlighted efforts of this committee and noted that the Law and Judicial Committee will be receiving updates on the integrated justice project about every 6 months. State's Attorney Waller stated that we are making progress with all the different integrations. State's Attorney Waller advised that the Juvenile Justice Council holds an annual seminar and training session. There is also a Domestic Violence Council; as well as the early stages of development of a coalition for sexual abuse and sexual assault - these groups plan to meet quarterly as does integrated justice. State's Attorney Waller stated that communication, cooperation and coordination is improved because of these coalitions and councils.

Ms. McEwan advised that State's Attorney Waller receives grants from the State and basically explained how grants come in and what is covered financially.
