# Intent:

This Request for Proposal (RFP) is for the purpose of establishing a contract with a vendor that can provide cost effective and medically necessary services and maintain a level of quality in accordance with current standards established by the National Commission on Correctional Health Care (NCCHC) and the American Correctional Association (ACA) for the Lake County Adult Correctional Facility and services for the Juvenile Detention Facility.



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#### Scope of Work:

Lake County intends to enter into a contract with a qualified vendor that provides all medical and mental health personnel, supervision, supplies, equipment, and pay all medical and pharmacy expenses necessary to provide a program for the provision of comprehensive health care services for Lake County Adult Corrections and 19<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit Court Juvenile Detention Center. The program shall meet constitutional and community standards of health care and, at a minimum, meet the standards of the National Commission on Correction Heath Care (NCCHC), the American Correction Association (ACA), and the Illinois Department of Corrections Jail and Juvenile Standards, and County Jail Standards.
