Lake County Affordable Housing Program Funding Recommendations

Phil Rovang, Building Planning and Development Department presented this program. The Community Development Division received 11 funding applications for 2009/2010. The Committee discussed the Program Criteria and risk analysis. Steve Carlson, Chairman, commented that the Staff recommendations and risk analysis did not cover the complexities of the program. He would like to see a ranking system. Each applicant made a brief presentation to the committee and answered questions from the committee.
