

Policy Goal



Institute a policy which guides the selection of products and services purchased by the County, which minimize negative impacts on human health and the environment, supporting sustainability and responsible resource use.



Bid Process



- Directed by Purchasing Ordinance
- Purchasing and requesting department define bid requirements
- Team evaluates bids submitted based on requirements
- Recommend award to lowest, responsive and responsible bidder

Compliance with the Responsible Bidders Ordinance






FY24 Total Number of POs

Next Steps






- Gather Baseline Data
