### ACTION REQUESTED: RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION - \$6,334,51

The Stormwater Management Commission received a Section 319 grant in 2017 to fund 3 projects throughout Lake County. \$6,334.51 of additional expense was approved by Illinois EPA for the Charles Brown Park project in the Village of Libertyville, which was completed in 2020 and this amount has been reimbursed to the Stormwater Management Commission.

This expense was not included in the original Emergency Appropriation for grant expenses and therefore requires an appropriation in order to pay the Village and close this project.

The additional funding is available due to surplus in other categories (personnel/fringe) funded by the overall Section 319 grant. Additionally, Illinois EPA has approved all project reports, cost documentation, and reimbursement requests to close out the grant. The grant provides cost-share funding on a reimbursement basis for 9.9 acres of wetland detention and 0.8 acres of sediment forebays in Charles Brown Park. The project is located on land owned by the Village on the north side of the Seavey Ditch.
