Update on the Swine Flu situation. (information only)

Irene Pierce along with Bill Mays and Victor Plotkin, from the Health Department presented information on the Swine Flu situation. The Health Department is working with health organizations and government organizations monitoring the progression and severity of the flu. Bill Mays reported that the Health Department is being pro-active and reaching out to schools and local governments to provide up-to-date information. They are setting up informational meetings with mayors and municipalities and schools. Member Feldman asked if there were any government agencies in Lake County that were not part of the communications plan they have established. Ms. Pierce said she would research it and get back an answer. The Health Department set up hotlines to

answer questions and kept the lines open on Saturday.

Dr. Plotkin stressed that is is imposible to predict the drift and shift of this flu because this it is a new virus. At this date the scientific and health communities and the World Health Organization are closly monitoring the situation.
