

**LAKE COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT AND COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTER
ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH FEES SCHEDULE**

All fees, excluding laboratory fees and fees established or controlled by Illinois statute or other authorized agencies, will be increased annually based on the Lake County Consumer Price Index.

Permit Fees for Food Service Establishments

New food service establishments and vending machine permits opening six (6) months or more after the permit due date will be assessed 50% of the appropriate fee.

Category 1 (High Risk) Facilities

| Retail/Food Service Combined >5,000 Square Feet | \$1,313 |
| Temporary Foodservice Event with Certified Manager or Trained Operator** | \$74 |
| Temporary Foodservice Event without Certified Manager or Trained Operator | \$155 |
| <u>Temporary Foodservice Multiple Event (Food Trucks Only) * **</u> | \$235 |

Not-For-Profit Category 3 Events and Not-For-Profit Category 1 and 2 Events with a Certified Manager or Trained Operator are exempt from the permit fee.

* *Temporary ~~Season~~ Multiple Event Fee Permits are valid for 6 months and allows a vendor to submit applications for multiple events during the calendar year, provided the full fee is paid with the first application.*

**** Permit holder has an operator present at the event who has successfully completed an American National Standards Institute (IL Dept of Public Health ANSI) certified food protection manager's or food handler course, or has attended a Lake County Health Dept-approved temporary event training course within that year (excluding Farmers' Market permits).**

† Farmers' Market permits are available only to farmers (as defined in the Food Handling Regulation Enforcement Act [410 ILCS 625/3.3]) operating at farmers' markets, are subject to the restrictions and requirements of 410 ILCS/625, and are valid for 1 year.

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| Temporary Event Permit Late Fees (Categories 1 and 2 only) | \$37 |
| <u>A late fee will be charged when a For Profit Vendor has not applied and paid _____ for a permit a minimum of seven (7) <u>three (3)</u> days prior to the <u>day of the</u> event (for example, if the event is on Saturday, the application and payment must be received by close of business Tuesday).</u> | \$50 |
| <u>Late fee when a For Profit Vendor applies and pays for a permit on the same day of the event.</u> | \$200 |
| <u>Cottage Food Operation Registration Fee</u> | \$50 |
