





Regulatory Highlights

- Adopted fill/grade ordinance amendments for unincorporated LC
- Adopted updates to the Lake County Building Codes (including fire suppression and EV-related changes)
- CRS Recertification retained rating as a Class 6 (20% discount on flood insurance premiums) via increased flood protection requirements, public education, etc.



Shared Services and Other Efficiencies:


- Continued to oversee consolidated waste hauling agreements
- Renewed temporary enforcement inspection program (lower cost, seasonal efficiencies)
- Delegated Isolated Waters of Lake County (IWLC) reviews to SMC to accommodate staffing efficiency
- Initial implementation of Samsara software to assist with inspection prioritization



Sustainability

- Bird-friendly building design policy adopted for LC facilities
- 177 acres of commercial solar projects in the review pipeline.
- 170 (FY23) residential solar projects approved (level with FY22 and up 63% from FY21).






2023 Residential Solar Project Locations

Permit Revenue




Total Permit Fees / Year: January to April



IGA Revenue






Permit Trend




Count of Permits / Year: January - April
