## 7.2 12-0950

Approval of a variance from Article 10 of the Unified Development Ordinance (UDO) to extend the performance assurance beyond the maximum permitted three-year period for Rockland Woods Subdivision.

- Rockland Woods Subdivision is located on the south side of Rockland Road approximately ½ mile west of St. Mary's Road in Libertyville Township (District 21).
- The County is has been holding a performance assurance since 2009 to insure completion of sanitary sewer, drainage, landscaping and roadway improvements; the assurance is scheduled to expire on September 18, 2012.
- The developer associated with the project was foreclosed upon by the lending
  institution that sponsored the letter of credit and staff has been working with a
  representative hired by the bank to complete the remaining items which will not be
  completed prior to the date of expiration.
- The bank is seeking a variance to extend the performance assurance beyond the

maximum permitted three year period to complete the remaining performance items in order to move the project into the maintenance period.

Staff recommends granting the requested variance.
