**A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE AVON-FREMONT DRAINAGE
DISTRICT COMMISSIONERS TO SUPPORT THE DISSOLUTION OF THE DISTRICT AS
PROPOSED BY THE COUNTY OF LAKE**

WHEREAS, the Avon-Fremont Drainage District (the "District") is an Illinois Drainage District under the laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, over time the character and use of properties located within the boundaries of the District have transitioned from rural uses to residential uses; and

WHEREAS, the County of Lake, Illinois, reasonably proposes the dissolution of the the District; and

WHEREAS, the County of Lake has statutory authority to initiate the dissolution of the District under 70 ILCS 605/10-7.3.

WHEREAS, the District desires that the remaining funds of the District be utilized for maintenance of the drainageways within the District boundaries and most of all of the drainageways are within the municipal boundaries of the Village of Grayslake; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the Avon-Fremont Drainage District, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Board of Commissioners declare and establish their intent to support and cooperate with the efforts of the County of Lake to dissolve the District.

SECTION 2: That the officials and agents of the District are hereby authorized and directed to take any and all actions which may be required to cooperate with the County of Lake to dissolve the district.

SECTION 3: That the District encourages and recommends that the remaining funds of the District be paid to the Village of Grayslake to be utilized for maintenance of the District drainageways.


SECTION 4: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon passage and approval.
