H1N1 Influenza Update (Information only)

Jerry Nordstrom and Victor Plotkin, from the Health Department presented an H1N1 Vaccination Update to the committee and answered members questions. Mr. Nordstrom said the vaccination clinics were chosen according to location of the greater population of those under the age of 24, which are in the priority or "high risk" group. The Health Department did not anticipate that they would be the only Lake County agency to receive the vaccine. The Health Department vaccinated more than 10,000 people in less than two days and hopes to recieve another shipment in two weeks (but does not have a confirmation date). Over 430 agencies have registered to receive the vaccination and at this time no one knows when they will receive a shipment.
