Joint resolution authorizing a contract with Radicom, Inc., McHenry, IL for the purchase of radio equipment for the Lake County Sheriff's Office for up to \$137,952.

- Lake County extended requests to 31 vendors and 3 bids were received.
- Three bids received ranged from \$91,026 to \$153,032.58, one bid was considered non-responsive.
- Radicom, Inc. was the lowest most responsive and responsible bidder.
- This contract authorizes a purchase of 36 radios for up to \$137,952.

19th JUDICIAL COURT**7.8** [12-0450](#)

Joint resolution authorizing a contract with the National Center for State Courts to conduct a thorough review of the current justice technologies, infrastructure, and governance including the development of recommendations, and approve an emergency appropriation in the amount of \$105,200.

- The National Center for State Courts (NCSC) will develop a technology governance structure for the Administrative Office of the Circuit Court of Lake County and the Circuit Court Clerk.
- Services will include documenting the required functionality for efficient and effective case management, document management, and e-filing as well as a gap analysis comparing the required functionality to the current system.
- NCSC will also assist the Court and the Court Clerk in developing a long-term strategy for meeting current and future case management needs.
- NCSC has engaged in work with the County on nine separate occasions since 1992 on assessment of governance, case management, E-Filing and issues relevant to Circuit Court matters.
- Pursuant to Article 6, section 102, the Purchasing Agent convened an ad hoc review group that approved bid exemption on the basis of an existing long standing successful relationship for professional services, and the knowledge gained through this relationship adds value integral to the services provided.

- This resolution also authorizes an emergency appropriation of \$105,200 from the fund balance in the court automation budget.

Joint resolution authorizing an emergency appropriation in the amount of \$45,000 in funding from the Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services and the approval of Grant Agreement No. 2012-55-024-K4D for the 19th Judicial Circuit's Access and Visitation Program for state fiscal year 2013.

- The 19th Judicial Circuit receives grant funding from the Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services to provide mediation services for never-married parents involved in visitation and custody-related disputes in an effort to increase child support collections from this population.
- The state would like to continue funding the 19th Judicial Circuit's program in the amount of \$45,000 for state fiscal year 2013.
- This access and visitation grant does not require matching funds.
- Last year, this program served 222 families.
