Vote to broaden scope of AHP 2013 Foreclosure Counseling and Mediation Grant

- Given the success in funding its new Foreclosure Counseling and Mediation Program with the Lake County Courts, the Affordable Housing Corporation of Lake County (AHC) has requested to repurpose this new initiative's recent \$45,000 grant from the Lake County Affordable Housing Program (AHP).
- AHC is requesting, and staff is recommending, that the scope of the AHP 2013 grant to
  AHC for \$45,000 be expanded for use by the agency for a broader range of needs, such as
  general operating and homeownership education/counseling for clients who don't buy a
  home in the near-term. (On such clients, AHC operates at a loss because it doesn't earn
  the \$500 counseling fee earned when a client buys a home with County assistance.)
