- 94% indicated that they had no other reasonable way to get to medical appointments.

Feeling more connected to their health care providers is a significant step towards developing a good relationship with their providers.

I am the Co-Chairperson of the Anti-Hunger Ministry of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul at St. Francis de Sales Parish in Lake Zurich. I am writing to ask for your support of the request from Northern Illinois Food Bank for Community Development Block Grant funding. This funding will directly support the St. Vincent de Paul Food Pantry that serves all of the residents of Lake County and six other food pantries that are also helping to provide food for hungry neighbors. Although we are located in Ela Township in the southwestern corner of the county, our clients come from all of the county's townships because we are one of the few food pantries that is open to the entire county, because we are open in the evening to accommodate low income earners and because we allow our clients to come for food every week.

They help to ensure that low- and moderate income individuals and families with limited English proficiency have the ability to access the community services they need in order to not just survive but thrive in their new community. While Mano a Mano serves primarily Latino immigrants, the struggling economy has caused an increasing number of non-immigrants to turn to us for assistance as well.

Our programs help the poorest of the poor in the area. The individuals served last fiscal year had an approximate average income of \$21,600 with an average family size of 4. Over 90% are Latino with very limited English proficiency. The great majority have completed less than 8 years of formal schooling.

Our Information & Referral program helps them have the support research has shown will enable them to break out of poverty. They receive answers to questions, find other sources of help and have access to the benefits, such as AllKids, SNAP, and Medicaid. Many say that they do not know they would do without our help. With the support of our Information and Referral program, adults can focus on learning English, gaining computer skills and obtaining a GED; their children can focus on their school work enabling communities to move out of poverty one family at a time.

Thank you again for taking the time to review our application and the initial positive funding recommendation. We hope that for the benefit of our community, his decision will become final.




Our Goal category is 3.2.1 – Basic Food & Nutrition Needs (there seems to be some errors in the Goals column of the 2013 Applications Recommendations Table we received). Of particular concern are COOL's scores in the 'Community Need' and 'Lake County Impact' categories.

Let me be clear: the primary activity of COOL Ministries is the operation of our two food pantries in Waukegan and Ingleside. We also operate a family housing program for families with children who have become homeless, and we consider this program quite important. But COOL's first program in 1983 was a food pantry, and serving our pantry clientele remains our number one focus in time, energy and finances. We are committed to providing not just food, but nutritious and balanced meals; we provide four days worth of breakfast, lunch and dinner for each member of a household, including specialty foods for those with food allergies and those requiring cardiac or diabetic diets. Under Goal 3.2.1, the need described includes both reducing food insecurity *and* improving healthy eating.

The CDBG grants are awarded under the details of the five-year Consolidated Plan, and COOL also operates using a five-year Strategic Plan. While each of our

pantries serve residents from anywhere in Lake County, we recognize that our pantries are located in the northern half of the county (Waukegan in the northeast and Ingleside in the northwest). One element of our strategic plan is to open a third pantry geographically located in the southern half of the county. However, before we take this step we must be assured that we can fully provide for the needs at our existing pantries – and those needs have grown dramatically over each of the last few years.

In 2011, the COOL Food Pantries served a record number of people and meals: 39,709 persons with food enough for 476,508 meals. In 2012, our pantries served 59,109 persons providing more than 709,000 meals. We broke our 2011 records by early September, and set a record for a single month by serving over 6,000 persons in October. The growth in need for food assistance is both dramatic and continuing at a high rate, as demonstrated by our numbers served since 2007:



Persons served by year: 26,650 in 2007; 28,497 in 2008; 37,877 in 2009; 37,578 in 2010; 39,709 in 2011; and 59,109 in 2012. Note: the "Five-Year Measurable Goal" of the Consolidated Plan calls for serving the basic food and nutrition needs of 100,000 Lake County residents. The COOL Food Pantries nearly met that goal in 2011 & 2012 alone (98,818).

In 2012, the COOL Food Pantries had an increase in persons served of 48.8% over 2011 – a difference of 19,400 more people! There was a huge increase in the amount of food COOL distributed in 2012 as well. In fact, 404,643 more pounds of food were distributed in 2012 as compared to 2011. This represents an increase in food issued of more than 98% over the prior year. In other words, in 2012 COOL

managed to feed more people than ever before and at the same time gave our visitors more food with every visit than in previous years.

One of the reasons we have thus far been able to keep up with the increased demands is our strategic partnerships – in particular our partnership with the Northern Illinois Food Bank. We have been chosen by them to receive donated bakery and produce items directly from retailers in our areas, rather than it going to their warehouses and being redistributed. This arrangement gets fresher, healthier food products into the hands of our guests, minimizes spoilage, and also minimizes the costs for both organizations. We have great respect for what NIFB does, and a tremendous working relationship with them. However, we are confused by the fact that an organization working to serve the same goals as COOL was recommended for an award when we were not.

I think it is important to point out two facts in this regard. First, the COOL Food Pantries directly assist those individuals in need. Providing basic food and nutritional support for families in need is our principal purpose. By contrast, for all their wonderful work, no individual in need can go to the NIFB and receive direct assistance.

Second, despite the donations of food from churches, food drives, and even from retailers, COOL still must purchase a great deal of food (especially meat) in order to distribute balanced meals. The vast majority of this food is purchased from NIFB. Therefore, of any CDBG money granted to the COOL pantries, a large portion would benefit not only COOL but also indirectly NIFB since it would be used to purchase food from them. On the other hand, grants to NIFB would not provide any traceable benefit to COOL's pantries.

Martin Luther King, Jr. once said, "Life's most persistent and urgent question is, 'What are you doing for others?'" At COOL Ministries, we feed the hungry and assist families in need. We respectfully ask you to reconsider the recommended award for COOL, and grant us funding to assist the low- and moderate-income residents of Lake County meet their basic food and nutrition needs.

On behalf of Highland Park Community Nursery School & Day Care Center I am submitting this written public comment for reconsideration of our request for funding. We had requested funding under 3.3.3 Security of Family and Social Stability.

When considering our request it seemed the fact that we are located in Highland Park was a detriment to our efforts to secure funding. At the review of our proposal it was mentioned we needed to serve a larger population. The number of clients we serve is mandated by the Department of Children and Family Services. If we have openings, we serve families and children on a first come first served basis. While we continue to, and have had a continuous waiting list for the past 20 years attests to the fact that a need exists in our community for affordable care for low income working families. A majority of our clients live and/or work in Highwood (population 5,405; 56.9% Hispanic)in service industry jobs that are low paying. About 80.3% of Highwood residents work in the service industry. Because these are minimum wage jobs, parents cannot afford to pay the actual cost of care whether it is provided in Highland Park, Round Lake or Waukegan. The location of the center should not interfere with the fact there is an extreme need for services by the very residents the Community Development Block Grant was intended to serve.

Highland Park and Highwood are part of the Lake County service area. We provide much needed services to the Lake County community and improve the livelihoods of its residents. Families who have used our services have been able to move out of low paying service jobs to start their own businesses with the skills they have acquired, and send their children to college who are now are a vital economic presence in the County. Childcare services enable parents to work to improve their economic situations while at the same time prepares their children for academic success that leads to economic security.

By serving a economically diverse population, mentoring of our clients is possible, thus expanding what they think they are capable of and how to accomplish these goals. With this awareness, parents come to believe their children can attend college and have a better and brighter future. Without this diversity, families may not be aware of all the possibilities and the potential for growth that exists. As a first generation college student myself who was raised from a poor working family, I speak to you from personal experience and hope that you will reconsider our request.

I also invite you to visit our program to experience the collaboration that takes place between families and our communities.

Below is Youth Conservation Corps (YCC) written comments to CDC Lake County's portion of the CDC Annual Action Plan

On December 6, 2012, I attended the CDC Application Review Committee - Public Service Meeting to determine funding to human service agencies serving Lake County Citizens. Youth Conservation Corps had applied for a grant under CDBG Public Service funds.

This is what I observed:

Only two members of what I believe was a committee of five should up for the meeting. I wondered why the staff continued the committee meeting, because I believe there was not a quorum of the committee. As the committee progress, staff told the committee they had \$270,000 to distribute to various programs. Staff then summarized the grant requests, and committee members followed along with their binder of what I assumed was the full grants. The committee then deliberated for 30 minutes and talked softly among them selves and flipped through their binders and scored each grant. If the committee did not read the grants before the committee meeting, I feel this was not sufficient time to evaluate the 27 grants submitted. The Staff then put a spread sheet from last year up on the screen and up dated the 27 applications and the total funding ask for and the scoring the committee had just done. Youth Conservation Corps received 158.00 points and was closely grouped (similar scores) with three other programs. There was various tries at spreading the funding to the top scores including full funding and % of funding. The committee seem to think that programs ask for all that they would need to run the program and made this a part of their decision making process, which I find is not true most agencies because of low CDBG funding look at this fund as part of funding and apply at various organization to complete the funding of a program. The committee seem interested in funding the next group of scores that Youth Conservation Corps and YouthBuild of Lake County were both in, but never cut the funding of the programs above in order to allow funding of the next group. When all was done the committee had used approximately \$240,000. They did not consider dividing up the excess \$30,000 to the next group that could use any amount to help to develop their programs.

Youth Conservation Corps (YCC) and YouthBuild of Lake County serve disadvantage young adults 16 - 24 years old. This population includes 85% high school drop outs, 50% ex-offenders, 5% to 50% single parents and most students come from three generations of poverty. Although we serve all of Lake County the average high school drop rate of the communities of poverty (North Chicago, Waukegan, Zion Round Lake area and Mundelein) that we serve have a high school drop out rate of over or close to 50%. Yet YCC only received 25 out of 30 points for need and I would challenge the other scores that we got so quickly too.

I would like the Lake County Consortium at their February 27 meeting to reconsider using the extra funds \$30,000 that they didn't use to fund the next group of scores (four I believe)

by dividing that amount by the number in that group, or reconsider the amounts to the other programs to provide overall funding to more programs with less funds. In these economic time with the State of Illinois owing eight billion dollars, Lake County Nonprofits need any amount of funds to help us to continue serving the needy in Lake County. I know this would help YCC and YouthBuild of Lake County with our programming.

Thank you for the opportunity to present our statement at the Public Hearing held on January 23, 2013 and to provide additional information to further support our request via this written document. We respectfully request the Commission's reconsideration of the Village of Beach Park's application for CDBG funding for the Village's proposed roadway improvement project.

We sincerely appreciate the thought and effort that you and the County staff devote to evaluating the applications received and allocating the available CDBG funds.

Based on staff's evaluation, the Village of Beach Park's application was ranked 16th of the twenty-two public infrastructure applications received. The Draft Plan includes a funding allocation for the top ranked fifteen applicants. The Village of Beach Park's application received a rating of 61.5, only 2.5 points below the three preceding applications which were tied with a score of 64 points. We are providing herein supplemental information not readily apparent in our application or the summary ranking that specifically addresses rating criteria identified by the Commission.

1. Applicant's capacity and experience in administering an activity in an efficient and timely manner or in overseeing the administration of the activity

As noted at the Public Hearing, the Village of Beach Park's application received 7.5 out of 10 possible points in the past performance category. The 2.5 point deduction was applied since the Village still has an open CDBG project from last year. Although this deduction was applied to other communities also, it should be noted that there were unique, extenuating circumstances associated with Beach Park's 2012 CDBG project. This project

circumstances associated with Beach Park's 2012 CDBG project. This project can only be done during the summer months while school is out, between May and August

The Village's 2012 CDBG project consists of major intersection improvements at Wadsworth Road and North Avenue, directly adjacent to a grade school as well as impacting many bus routes for two other school districts. If the CDBG funding commitment had been available in May of last year, the project could have been completed by the fall of 2012. Since the federal HUD funds were not available until July, 2012, the project had to be delayed to coordinate with school schedules. The project is ready to bid and will be executed when school is out of session this summer. Per the grant requirements, the project will be completed well in advance of the December 31, 2013 deadline. Simply put, if the funds had been available earlier in the year the project would be completed and the Village would have received an additional 2.5 point in this category.

2. Degree to which funds are leveraged with other sources

Since the time of the original filing of the application, additional field work has been completed to assess the necessary drainage improvements in the project corridor. With the drainage improvements and other soft costs added to the project total, the updated project cost estimate is approximately \$170,000. (The project cost estimate is provided in the attached Exhibit.) The requested \$100,000 in CDBG funds is less than 59% of the project total. Based on this additional information, the application should have indicated that the Village was committing to leverage 41% of the funds for this project from other sources. This would result in an additional 2 points in this category, totaling 4.5 additional points in the overall scoring system.

3. Health, Safety and Welfare Concerns

The Village of Beach Park recently completed a pavement evaluation study, rating the condition of the streets within the Village in accordance with the Asphalt Institute Rating System. The streets within the proposed project area are in very poor condition, receiving street ratings in the range of 50 – 60. The poor conditions were primarily attributed to significant cracking, raveling, potholes and drainage issues. The individual rating sheets for the four impacted street sections are attached. Although not specifically detailed in the application, drainage improvements are planned and required in conjunction with the roadway improvements project. The creation of ditches where there currently are none, replacement of culverts, and re-grading of existing ditches (as indicated on the attached sketches) will provide positive

drainage away from the private properties within the project corridor. The proposed project addresses not only roadway restructuring but also drainage deficiencies, thus it has an even greater impact on the livelihood of the residents in the area.

The scoring system that was applied to all of the applications attempted to differentiate between the projects based on urgency and need. Only three point totals were assigned in this scoring category – 0, 15 or 25 points. The vast majority of the applications (including the Village of Beach Park) received 15 out of the possible 25 points in this category. Only four applicants (those ranked 1st, 3rd, 12th and 15th) received the 25 point rating in this category. If the urgency and need of the planned drainage improvements described above had been factored into the scoring system, additional points could have been assigned to the Village's application.

4. Degree to which activity addresses community needs impacting lowand moderate-income people

In response to preference given for low to moderate income projects, 7 of the 15 entities receiving an allocation in the Draft Plan have a higher median household income than the Village of Beach Park. The score allocated in this category is allocated in blocks, as opposed to a sliding scale. Therefore, while the scoring system partially accounts for economic status of the community, this scoring system does not directly reflect of the community's true need. Below is an excerpt from the scoring summary for illustration purposes:

The Village of Beach Park, like many communities in Lake County, continues to have to delay necessary infrastructure projects due to a lack of funding sources. The local share of the state administered Motor Fuel Tax program has become insufficient to adequately maintain the Village streets. Based on the current share of MFT allocation received by the Village, it would take nearly 80 years to complete one round of street resurfacing within the Village. Leveraging additional funds has become increasingly challenging, particularly in this current economy. Receiving CDBG funds is crucial for the Village, as the Village funds alone cannot pay for the entire project, despite the described necessity.

Based on the supplemental information provided, we respectfully request a reconsideration of the proposed funding allocation in the 2013 Annual Action Plan to include an allocation for the Village of Beach Park. We appreciate your time and consideration of this request.


