| D | Industry Exposure Learning: Details on meaningful industry engagement opportunities, including mentorship, site visits, and employer networking, ensuring participants receive hands-on sector experience. |
| E | Budget and Financial Management Plan: Comprehensive budget outlining overall cost and cost per participant, including tuition, career coaching, and workforce readiness initiatives. Clear fiscal management plan detailing accounting procedures, auditing, compliance controls, and previous experience managing federal workforce development funds (if applicable). |
| F | Performance Metrics & Training Outcomes: Defined measurable benchmarks, including total enrollments, credential attainment, program completion rates, employment placement outcomes, and participant wage tracking. The proposal should demonstrate the likelihood of achieving WIOA performance standards and improving workforce readiness in manufacturing. |
