Resolution to vacate an unimproved portion of Cherry Lane located in the Arthur T. McIntosh and Company's Brigg's Lake Subdivision in Ela Township.

- Thomas F. Naples and Deanna J. Naples, record owners, are requesting the vacation of an unimproved portion of Cherry Lane, adjacent to 23512 N Cedar Lane, in Lake Zurich, Illinois.
- The proposed right-of-way sought to be vacated is approximately 33.3 feet wide, extending approximately 289.40 feet west, and consists of approximately 0.22 acres.
- The right-of-way has not been improved nor accepted by the Ela Township Highway Commissioner. The Highway Commissioner has no objections to the proposed vacation.
- ComEd requested a utility easement which has been provided by the applicant and

therefore has no objections to the proposed vacation.

- The Board of Vacations held a public hearing on October 1, 2025, and recommended granting the vacation unanimously, conditioned upon the inclusion of a utility easement on the plat.
- Following a recommendation by the Planning, Building, Zoning and Environment Committee, the vacation request will proceed to the County Board for final action.

Presentation of Indian Creek Stream Assessment and Community Outreach.

- The Lake County Stormwater Management Commission (SMC) hosted a community outreach meeting at the Vernon Township Community Building to discuss local perspectives on the current condition of Indian Creek and potential opportunities for drainage improvements.
- Pursuant to 55 ILCS 5/5-1104.4, SMC issued a written 30-day notice of planned stream assessment work to all property owners along Indian Creek between Buffalo Grove Road and Port Clinton Road.
- Staff will present the findings of the stream assessment conducted between
 October 1, 2025, and October 17, 2025, along with an example of an Indian Creek
 restoration project that was implemented upstream of Buffalo Grove Road.

Discussion regarding a grant application for a proposed three new level 2 electric vehicle charging stations at 650 W. Winchester Road and a proposed three new level 2 electric vehicle charging stations at 2400 Belvidere Rd.

- The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Climate and Equitable Jobs Act
 (CEJA) Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Round 3 is open for grant applications to
 fund public Level 2 and Level 3 fast charging across Illinois and is estimated to be
