8.3 25-1045

Joint resolution approving an agreement between Lake County and North Chicago School District 187 for the completion of an Environmental Review Record (ERR).

- North Chicago School District 187 is the recipient of U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Community Project Funding (CPF) for their facility renovation project, which requires a HUD compliant Environmental Review Record (ERR).
- Lake County, as a unit of general local government, is a Responsible Entity (RE) and is authorized to perform the ERR for certain funding entities that do not meet the definition of a RE, such as District 187.
- The terms of the attached Agreement have been reviewed by the State's Attorney's Office and are consistent with previous agreements to perform ERRs.
- The terms indicate that Lake County will be reimbursed for all expenses incurred in

completing the ERR and will be used to offset the expenses incurred.

Joint resolution approving an extension to an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) between Lake County and the Lake County Housing Authority (LCHA) for the completion of 24 CFR Part 58 Environmental Review Records (ERRs).

- On October 11, 2022, Lake County and LCHA entered into an IGA for the completion of 24 CFR Part 58 ERRs.
- To continue services an extension is needed under existing IGA terms and allows for four one-year extensions.
- Lake County and LCHA mutually desire to extend all the terms and conditions of the IGA for the period beginning October 11, 2025, through October 10, 2026.

Joint resolution accepting the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) from Illinois Department of Human Services and authorizing an emergency appropriation in the amount of \$32,776 for grant administration and management of the Homeless Management Information System (HMIS).

- The \$32,776 in grant funds covers a portion of the HMIS Administrator position, which provides grant administration and management of the Homeless Management Information System (HMIS).
- The \$32,776 in grant funding has not been previously appropriated because the grant resources were secured after the County's adoption of the Fiscal Year 2025 budget.

8.6 25-1102

Joint resolution authorizing an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) between the County of Lake (through the Lake County Health Department) and the Village of Lakemoor pertaining to the delegation of enforcement authority for Onsite Waste Treatment System provisions in the Ports of Sullivan Lake.

- The Ports of Sullivan is approximately 40 acres, developed as a seasonal recreational park during the 1980's permitted by the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH).
- The site housed many recreational vehicles and non-permanent type structures which addressed their sanitary sewer service needs via holding tanks.
- In 1987, the IDPH became aware of significant code compliance issues that were causing enforcement difficulties as the area began to be used more for full-time residential uses.

- In the 1990s, the enforcement authority for the holding tanks was turned over to the Lake County Health Department (LCHD) and, since then, several unsuccessful agreements were made between LCHD and the Ports of Sullivan to enforce sewage disposal concerns.
- The Village of Lakemoor is desirous of enforcing specified health codes of LCHD
 to effectuate code enforcement with the intent of preventing environmental harm as
 well as to reduce or minimize potential negative health impacts on the residents
 and the surrounding area.

WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

8.7 <u>25-1107</u>

Joint committee action approving Contract Modification One with North Chicago High School (District 187) for a Comprehensive Career Pathway Program to Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Youth in the amount of \$137,900 with one one-year renewal option.

- Lake County's current contract term with North Chicago High School District 187 for a Comprehensive Career Pathway Program is set to expire.
- The scope of the contract includes providing a stipend to students for career exploration and essential workplace readiness for the first semester of the school year to prepare high school seniors for an onsite internship in the second half of the school year.
- There is a need to continue services beyond the original contract term to serve 35 additional students.
- The contract modification will be funded by Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) PY25 Grant Funds in an amount not to exceed \$137,900 and extends the current contract term to July 30, 2026.
- Pursuant to Chapter 33.082 Change Orders and Contract Modifications, this Contract Modification is germane to the original contract as signed and is in the best interest of Lake County.
- This joint committee action authorizes the Purchasing Agent to enter into Contract Modification One with North Chicago High School District 187 in an amount not to exceed \$137,900, extend the current term of the agreement through June 30, 2026, and provide an option of one one-year renewal, if additional grant funds are awarded.
