Joint resolution authorizing a contract with Conference Technologies, Inc of Itasca, Illinois, in the amount of \$49,915.42 and \$5,863.38 to furnish and install the audio/visual equipment in the Juvenile Depke Probation Training Room (3rd Floor, New Building).

- There is a need to provide ongoing technical and safety training for the workforce to be effective and safe. Training is provided on the use of specialized equipment, policy, and procedures while performing work in difficult environment, i.e., confined spaces and trenches.
- Purchasing identified a cooperative purchasing contract with Conference Technologies, Inc. of Itasca, Illinois, through a Joint Purchasing contract.
- Pursuant to Article 33.115 Cooperative Joint Purchasing of the Lake County Purchasing Ordinance, Lake County may participate in a cooperative purchasing agreement.
- This resolution authorizes and directs the County Purchasing Agent to execute a contract with Conference Technologies, Inc, Itasca, Illinois, in the amount of \$49,915.42 and \$5,863.38 for technology equipment and services to furnish and

install the Juvenile Depke Probation Training Room (3rd Floor, New Building).

8.4 **25-0739**

Joint resolution authorizing an agreement with AdGators.com, LLC, of Springfield, Illinois, for purchase of a self-service kiosk for the 19th Judicial Circuit Court of Lake County in the amount of \$45,396.

- The Lake County 19th Judicial Circuit Court is pursuing a wayfinding, interactive system to better assist the public with navigating the courts.
- AdGators has been utilized by the 19th Judicial Circuit Court of Lake County since 2018 for the Court docket display system.
- Pursuant to Chapter 33.066 Bid Exemption of the Lake County Purchasing Ordinance, the Purchasing Agent has made a determination based on previous bid exemptions (2025) on the basis of an existing long-standing successful relationship, and the knowledge gained through this relationship adds value integral to the services provided.
- This agreement provides for the hardware purchase, software licensing and support services and the set up and implementation fees.
- The total cost is \$45,396.

8.5 **25-0741**

Joint committee action approving Contract Modification Number Six with Journal Technologies, Inc., of Los Angeles, California for the purchase of eSupervision as part of the Integrated Case Management System for the 19th Judicial Circuit Court for professional services to include implementation, conversion, additional interfaces and hosting services in the amount of \$983,500 and annual software maintenance costs beginning in year two in the annual amount of \$283,337 with a three percent increase each year.

- The County Board approved a contract with JTI in April 2019 to implement an Integrated Case Management System, with subsequent amendments in 2020 and 2022 for cloud storage, deferred interfaces, and data conversion totaling \$80,000.
- Amendments Three through Five (July 2022-September 2023) adjusted the project scope, converted Family Maintenance data, established a new go-live timeline,

and rescheduled interface deliveries.

- In April 2025, the County Board approved acceptance of a Funding Agreement for the Supreme Court of Illinois Court Technology Modernization Program to replace all Case Management systems used by Adult Probation & Pretrial Services, Psychological Services and Juvenile Probation & Detention Services to “eSupervision” -Journal Technologies Inc., will support the integration of all systems currently use by Justice partners (eCourt, eProsecutor, eDefender). This will also provide a seamless interface in providing data/information required by Administrative Office of Illinois Courts (AOIC).
- In accordance with Section 33.082 of the Lake County Purchasing Ordinance, this contract modification is germane to the original contract as signed and is in the best interest of Lake County, it is hereby requested that the Purchasing Agent be authorized to enter into Contract Modification Number Six.
- This modification authorizes the purchase of eSupervision as part of the Integrated Case Management System for the 19th Judicial Circuit Court for professional services to include implementation, conversion, additional interfaces and hosting services in the amount of \$983,500 and annual software maintenance costs beginning in year two in the annual amount of \$283,337 with a three percent annual increase for years three through five.

Joint resolution authorizing a contract with Motorola Solutions, Inc., of Schaumburg, Illinois, the incumbent vendor, in the amount of \$269,570 for a replacement Distributed Amplifier System (DAS) for the Starcom radio network’s Waukegan campus.

- The current DAS system is over 10 years old and is not performing as expected.
- This was discovered in mid-March when high wind took out a radio antenna on the Waukegan campus.
- Pursuant to Chapter 33.066 Bid Exemption of the Lake County Purchasing Ordinance, the Purchasing Agent has made a determination based on previous bid exemptions (August 8, 2023) that there is only one source for the required goods, service or construction item.
