Resolution approving the rezoning of properties located at 28449 and 28445 Arcadia Road in Libertyville Township from Limited Industrial to Agricultural (zoning case 3956).

- The applicants, International Precision Components Corporation and Karen Marie Stolzman, as trustee of the Karen Marie Stolzman Revocable Trust, request a rezoning from the Limited Industrial (LI) zone to the Agricultural (AG) zone.
- The applicants originally intended to use the properties for a factory use, but pursuant to an agreement with the Lake County Forest Preserve District agreed to not construct such a building.
- The applicants now desire to construct a single-family dwelling unit for themselves.
- Following a public hearing on April 4, 2011, the ZBA recommended approval of the request by a vote of 7-0.
- The Planning, Building & Development Department also recommends approval.

The petitioner, Mr. Michael Stolzman of 1188 Old Colony Road in Lake Forest, stated the purpose of the rezoning was to accommodate one single family home on the property. The parcel is located in Member Gravenhorst's district; she stated that she has no objections to this request.

Director's Report

Mr. Eric Waggoner, Acting Director for the Planning, Building, & Development, presented the Department's FY2010 Annual Report to the committee, and went on to update the committee about various customer service initiatives, including the County's Integrated Permitting Process. A brief discussion ensued about the status of the County's multi-agency Administrative Adjudication project. Committee members expressed satisfaction with the County's efforts.

Member Pedersen asked for an update on pending wind energy legislation in Springfield. Ryan Waller, Assistant County Administrator, noted that House Bill 230 seeks to limit regulatory restrictions on individual wind facilities in counties, but that through our lobbying efforts Lake County will be exempt from the proposed limits under the bill's current language. A Senate amendment is anticipated as well regarding fees.

Mr. Ryan Waller stated that the public informational meeting to discuss the proposed landscape waste burning restrictions around Stevenson High School will be held on Monday May 9, 2011, from 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm.
