Krista Barkley Braun, Deputy Director & Zoning Administrator, Planning, Building and Development (PB&D) Department, and Taylor Gendel, Senior Planner, PB&D, provided a presentation regarding proposed text amendments to the Lake County, Illinois Code of Ordinances to enhance the planting and protection of native tree and plant species in unincorporated Lake County. Discussion ensued.

The consensus of the Committee was for staff to work with Openlands to increase the minimum percentage of native tree and shrub plantings required by the proposed amendments to the Ordinance.

Matt Meyers, Assistant County Administrator, noted that the State's Attorney's Office has reviewed the issue previously brought up by Member Roberts regarding a potential ban of the release of helium balloons in Lake County. The State's Attorney's Office found that since Lake County is not a home rule county, Lake County does not have the authority to impose such a ban. Discussion ensued.
