

**AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF LAKE
AND THE CITY OF WAUKEGAN FOR THE
IMPROVEMENT, MAINTENANCE AND JURISDICTIONAL
TRANSFER OF LEWIS AVENUE (COUNTY HIGHWAY 27)
FROM 14TH STREET TO BELVIDERE STREET**

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into this _____ day of _____, A.D. 20___, by and between the COUNTY OF LAKE, Illinois, an Illinois body politic and corporate, acting by and through its Chair and County Board, hereinafter referred to as the COUNTY, and the City of Waukegan, an Illinois municipal corporation, acting by and through its Mayor and City Council, hereinafter referred to as the CITY. The COUNTY and the CITY are hereinafter referred to collectively as “parties” to THIS AGREEMENT, and either one is referred to individually as a “party” to THIS AGREEMENT.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the COUNTY, in order to facilitate the free flow of traffic and ensure the safety of the motoring public, is desirous of making certain interim roadway improvements to Lewis Avenue from 14th Street to Belvidere Street, an unmarked State highway, (hereinafter INTERIM IMPROVEMENT). Said INTERIM IMPROVEMENT shall include, but not be limited to, the milling and resurfacing of pavement, pavement patching, storm sewer repairs, and concrete curb and gutter repair, and shall be known as County Section 16-00082-08-RS; and,

WHEREAS, the INTERIM IMPROVEMENT is located within the CITY’s corporate limits and the CITY presently has jurisdictional authority over Lewis Avenue from 14th Street to Sunset Avenue; and,

WHEREAS, Lewis Avenue is an existing municipal extension of County Highway 27 between 14th Street and Dugdale Road (hereinafter MUNICIPAL EXTENSION); and,

WHEREAS, the COUNTY shall prepare all surveys, design engineering plans and specifications, bid documents and furnish construction engineering supervision, and cause the INTERIM IMPROVEMENT to be built in accordance with the approved plans, specifications, and construction contract, (hereinafter PLANS). As of this writing, the current PLANS are those dated July 27, 2016 (pre-final version) prepared by the COUNTY’s Division of Transportation (hereinafter LCDOT). Said PLANS by reference herein are hereby made a part hereof; and,

WHEREAS, the COUNTY shall receive bids, award the construction contract, furnish construction engineering supervision and cause the INTERIM IMPROVEMENT to be constructed in accordance with the PLANS without reimbursement from the CITY; and,

WHEREAS, the COUNTY, upon completion of the INTERIM IMPROVEMENT, is desirous to assume jurisdiction of and add the MUNICIPAL EXTENSION segment of Lewis Avenue, and that segment of Lewis Avenue from the MUNICIPAL EXTENSION to Belvidere Street, to the COUNTY highway system as COUNTY HIGHWAY 27, exclusive of the existing municipal facilities along Lewis Avenue, including but not limited to, watermain, sanitary sewer, sidewalk and street lights (hereinafter MUNICIPAL FACILITIES); and,

WHEREAS, the CITY is desirous to transfer the jurisdiction of Lewis Avenue from 14th Street to Belvidere Street to the COUNTY; and,

WHEREAS, a project location map indicating the approximate INTERIM IMPROVEMENT limits and the limits of the jurisdictional transfer is attached hereto as EXHIBIT A and is hereby made a part hereof; and,

WHEREAS, the CITY agrees to continue ownership and maintenance responsibility for any and all of its existing MUNICIPAL FACILITIES along Lewis Avenue and for any MUNICIPAL FACILITIES constructed as part of the INTERIM IMPROVEMENT and to sign a Municipal Utility/Facility Acceptance on a County Highway form, or forms as the case may be, and maintain said MUNICIPAL FACILITIES in accordance with Chapter 91 of the Lake County Code of Ordinances, as amended, and any successor document; and,

WHEREAS, the CITY and the COUNTY have expressed their desire to partner together to provide maintenance for Lewis Avenue from 14th Street to Belvidere Street. The CITY agrees to perform routine maintenance (hereinafter ROUTINE MAINTENANCE) and the COUNTY agrees to perform capital maintenance (hereinafter CAPITAL MAINTENANCE); and,

WHEREAS, the parties hereto are each desirous to execute the appropriate Illinois Department of Transportation Local Agency Agreement for Jurisdictional Transfer Form necessary to effect the transfer of Lewis Avenue, from 14th Street to Belvidere Street, to the COUNTY. An example of said Local Agency Agreement is attached hereto as EXHIBIT B and is hereby made a part hereof; and,

WHEREAS, the CITY shall retain permitting authority of Lewis Avenue from 14th Street to Belvidere Street; and,

WHEREAS, the CITY and the COUNTY agree that Lewis Avenue will need a CAPITAL MAINTENANCE improvement in the future to reconstruct the pavement and improve the roadway (hereinafter FUTURE IMPROVEMENT); and,

WHEREAS, the INTERIM IMPROVEMENT as heretofore described will be of immediate benefit to the residents of the COUNTY and the CITY and will be permanent in nature;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, made pursuant to all applicable statutes, local ordinances and authority, the COUNTY and the CITY do hereby agree as follows:

**SECTION I.
Recitals/Headings**

1. It is mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto that the foregoing preambles are hereby incorporated herein as though fully set forth.
2. It is mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto that the “headings” as contained in THIS AGREEMENT are for reference only and the actual written provisions, paragraphs and words of THIS AGREEMENT shall control.

**SECTION II.
The Design, Construction and Maintenance of the INTERIM IMPROVEMENT**

1. The COUNTY shall prepare, or cause to be prepared, the necessary surveys, design engineering plans and specifications and contract letting documents for the INTERIM IMPROVEMENT in accordance with LCDOT policies and standards, as approved by the Illinois Department of Transportation (hereinafter IDOT), at the COUNTY’s sole expense.

As of this writing, the current PLANS are the pre-final set of plans prepared by the LCDOT, dated July 27, 2016. Said PLANS, by reference herein, hereby become a part hereof.

The CITY shall have the opportunity to review and approve said PLANS with respect to the CITY’s MUNICIPAL FACILITIES. Said review and approval of the PLANS by the CITY shall not be unnecessarily withheld.

2. It is mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto that the COUNTY shall process the construction of the INTERIM IMPROVEMENT to be let and awarded by LCDOT. As of this writing, the anticipated letting date for the INTERIM IMPROVEMENT is January 31,

2017. (The letting date is subject to change, without notice to the CITY and is dependent upon project readiness and the availability of project funding).

3. The COUNTY agrees to cause the INTERIM IMPROVEMENT to be constructed and to perform, or caused to be performed, the construction engineering supervision for the INTERIM IMPROVEMENT in accordance with LCDOT procedures and requirements as approved by IDOT, without reimbursement from the CITY.
4. The CITY agrees that, by executing THIS AGREEMENT, the CITY concurs in the award of the construction contract for the INTERIM IMPROVEMENT by the COUNTY in accordance with the standard policies and procedures as adopted and in use by the LCDOT.
5. It is mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto that, upon completion of the INTERIM IMPROVEMENT, the CITY shall continue to own and maintain the MUNICIPAL FACILITIES within the right-of-way of Lewis Avenue, from 14th Street to Belvidere Street, without reimbursement from the COUNTY in perpetuity.

It is further mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto that the CITY must submit to the COUNTY, for the COUNTY's approval, an executed standard form, MUNICIPAL UTILITY/FACILITY ACCEPTANCE ON A COUNTY HIGHWAY (hereinafter MUNICIPAL ACCEPTANCE FORM) by December 1, 2016 for the maintenance of the MUNICIPAL FACILITIES within the right-of-way of Lewis Avenue, the approval of which shall not be unreasonably withheld by the COUNTY.

6. It is mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto that, upon completion of the jurisdictional transfer to the COUNTY, the CITY shall continue to have the sole and exclusive right to issue any and all permits for any work, construction, reconstruction, access, and/or placement of any utilities or facilities within the rights-of-way for Lewis Avenue from 14th Street to Belvidere Street.
7. It is further mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto that for purposes of THIS AGREEMENT, the CITY shall continue to perform ROUTINE MAINTENANCE along Lewis Avenue from 14th Street to Belvidere Street upon approval of the Jurisdictional Transfer by IDOT. ROUTINE MAINTENANCE shall include items such as the removal of debris, removal of graffiti from signage, replacement and/or reinstallation of damaged signage, street sweeping, repair of potholes, minor curb repair, televising and cleaning storm sewer, storm sewer structure adjustments, and landscaping maintenance (including but not limited to mowing, removal of vegetation obscuring visibility of signs or limiting sight distance at intersections, and keeping areas around signs and other highway appurtenances clear,) snow plowing, ice removal and salting of the roadway. Said

ROUTINE MAINTENANCE shall be performed by the CITY without reimbursement from the COUNTY in perpetuity.

8. It is mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto that for purposes of THIS AGREEMENT, the COUNTY shall perform CAPITAL MAINTENANCE along Lewis Avenue from 14th Street to Belvidere Street upon approval of the Jurisdictional Transfer of Lewis Avenue by IDOT. CAPITAL MAINTENANCE shall include replacement of items that have outlived their useful life, and shall include items such as full depth pavement patching, resurfacing, pavement widening, pavement reconstruction, storm sewer removal and replacement, pavement striping, replacement of recessed pavement markers, tree removal upon notice from the CITY due to clear signs of danger (such as disease, split limbs, or excessive lean), and end of life signage replacement. Said CAPITAL MAINTENANCE shall be performed by the COUNTY without reimbursement from the CITY in perpetuity.

9. The CITY agrees that upon approval of the Jurisdictional Transfer of Lewis Avenue by IDOT, the permanent traffic control signals and equipment with interconnect, the emergency vehicle pre-emption system (hereinafter EVPS) and the combination poles for street lights at the intersection of Lewis Avenue and 14th Street, at Lewis Avenue and 10th Street and at Lewis Avenue and Dugdale Road shall become the sole and exclusive property of the COUNTY.

The CITY further agrees that the COUNTY shall have the sole and exclusive right to control, operate, and regulate the sequence and all other aspects of the timing of the permanent traffic control signals and equipment with interconnect and the emergency vehicle pre-emption system along Lewis Avenue within the CITY upon approval of the Jurisdictional Transfer of Lewis Avenue by IDOT.

10. Upon approval of the Jurisdictional Transfer of Lewis Avenue by IDOT, the COUNTY agrees to maintain, or cause to be maintained, the traffic control signals and equipment with interconnect and any EVPS along Lewis Avenue from 14th Street to Belvidere Street, subject to reimbursement by the CITY as stipulated in the Master Traffic Signal Agreement between the COUNTY and the CITY dated June 13, 2008 for COUNTY-owned Traffic Control Devices (hereinafter COUNTY-owned TRAFFIC SIGNAL AGREEMENT), as amended.

11. The CITY and the COUNTY are in the process of entering into a new Master Agreement for CITY-owned Traffic Control Devices concurrently with THIS AGREEMENT. The CITY agrees to maintain, or cause to be maintained, the traffic signals and equipment with interconnect, the EVPS and the combination poles for street lights located along Lewis

Avenue from 14th Street to Belvidere Street as stipulated in the Master Agreement between the CITY and the COUNTY dated _____ for CITY-owned Traffic Control Devices (hereinafter CITY-owned TRAFFIC SIGNAL AGREEMENT), as amended, until the Jurisdictional Transfer of Lewis Avenue has been approved by IDOT.

12. The CITY agrees to reimburse the COUNTY for all costs for the repair, replacement, and maintenance and all other work performed for the COUNTY-owned traffic control signals and equipment with interconnect, the EVPS and the combination poles for the street lights, along Lewis Avenue from 14th Street to Belvidere Street, as defined in said COUNTY TRAFFIC SIGNAL AGREEMENT.

The CITY further agrees to be responsible for one hundred percent (100%) of energy costs, with no reimbursement from the COUNTY, associated with the traffic signals and equipment with interconnect, the EVPS and the combination poles for street lights located at the intersections of Lewis Avenue and 14th Street, Lewis Avenue and 10th Street and at Lewis Avenue and Dugdale Road.

13. It is mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto that from time to time said traffic control signals and equipment, the combination poles for street lights, the EVPS and the interconnect along Lewis Avenue from 14th Street to Belvidere Street shall require modernization, improvement, revision, replacement, major repairs, upgrading, and/or interconnection with adjoining traffic control signals. The CITY agrees, that upon written notification from the COUNTY's County Engineer (hereinafter COUNTY ENGINEER), the CITY shall pay the appropriate portion of all future costs, upon approval of funding, for said modernization, improvement, revision, upgrading, replacement, major repairs, and/or interconnection as defined in the COUNTY TRAFFIC SIGNAL AGREEMENT.

SECTION III.

Jurisdictional Transfer

1. The CITY and the COUNTY, by virtue of their powers as set forth in the Illinois Highway Code 605 ILCS 5/5-106, have agreed to a jurisdictional transfer of the currently designated Municipal Extension of County Highway Lewis Avenue from 14th Street to Dugdale Road and of Lewis Avenue from Dugdale Road to Belvidere Street.
2. The CITY agrees to pass an ordinance, in accordance with Section 4-409 of the Illinois Highway Code, and the policies and procedures of the State of Illinois acting by and through IDOT, transferring jurisdiction of Lewis Avenue, from 14th Street to Belvidere Street, to the COUNTY. The CITY further agrees to execute the appropriate IDOT Local

Agency Agreement for Jurisdictional Transfer form. A copy of the current Local Agency Agreement for Jurisdictional Transfer Form is attached to THIS AGREEMENT as EXHIBIT B.

3. The COUNTY agrees to adopt a resolution, in accordance with Section 4-409 of the Illinois Highway Code, and the policies and procedures of IDOT, adding Lewis Avenue from 14th Street to Belvidere Street, to the COUNTY highway system. The COUNTY further agrees to execute the appropriate IDOT Local Agency Agreement for Jurisdictional Transfer Form.
4. It is mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto that upon approval of the jurisdictional transfer by IDOT, the CITY shall retain ownership and maintenance responsibilities for all existing MUNICIPAL FACILITIES within the Lewis Avenue right-of-way from 14th Street to Belvidere Street.

SECTION IV.

The Design and Construction of the FUTURE IMPROVEMENT

1. It is mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto that a FUTURE IMPROVEMENT shall be made to Lewis Avenue to reconstruct the pavement and improve the roadway. The limits of the FUTURE IMPROVEMENT on Lewis Avenue are anticipated to be from 14th Street to Belvidere Street.
2. The COUNTY has programmed funding within its 2016-2021 Highway Improvement Program toward the FUTURE IMPROVEMENT. At this time, design engineering is programmed to begin within COUNTY fiscal year 2019 and right-of-way acquisition is programmed to begin within COUNTY fiscal year 2021. Although construction of the FUTURE IMPROVEMENT is not currently funded within the COUNTY's 2016-2021 Highway Improvement Program, the COUNTY intends to cause the contract for construction of the FUTURE IMPROVEMENT to be awarded on or before December 1, 2025.
3. It is mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto that the FUTURE IMPROVEMENT is anticipated to include adjustment and/or possible relocation and replacement of CITY MUNICIPAL FACILITIES. The CITY shall be responsible for its share of the design engineering, right-of-way and/or easement acquisition, construction and construction engineering costs attributable to the CITY's MUNICIPAL FACILITIES as part of the FUTURE IMPROVEMENT. The COUNTY will coordinate design engineering, right-of-way and/or easement acquisition, and construction of the FUTURE IMPROVEMENT with the CITY to allow for the CITY's budgetary planning purposes.

SECTION V.
General Provisions

1. It is mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto that nothing contained in THIS AGREEMENT is intended or shall be construed as, in any manner or form, creating or establishing a relationship of co-partners between the parties hereto, or as constituting the CITY (including its elected officials, duly appointed officials, employees and agents) the agent, representative or employee of the COUNTY for any purpose or in any manner, whatsoever. The CITY is to be and shall remain independent of the COUNTY, and vice-versa, with respect to all services performed under THIS AGREEMENT.
2. It is mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto that THIS AGREEMENT shall not be construed, in any manner or form, to limit the power or authority of the COUNTY ENGINEER to maintain, operate, improve, construct, reconstruct, repair, manage, widen or expand COUNTY Highways as may be best determined, as provided by law.
3. It is mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto that each party warrants and represents to the other party and agrees that: (1) THIS AGREEMENT is executed by duly authorized agents or officers of such party and that all such agents and officers have executed the same in accordance with the lawful authority vested in them, pursuant to all applicable and substantive requirements; (2) THIS AGREEMENT is binding and valid and will be specifically enforceable against each party; and (3) THIS AGREEMENT does not violate any presently existing provision of law nor any applicable order, writ, injunction or decree of any court or government department, commission, board, bureau, agency or instrumentality applicable to such party.
4. The CITY agrees, during and upon completion of the INTERIM IMPROVEMENT, to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the COUNTY, its elected officials, duly appointed officials, agents, employees and representatives and the LCDOT, its duly appointed officials, agents, employees, and representatives from and against, any and all claims, suits, settlements, actions, losses, expenses, damages, injuries, judgments and demands (collectively referred to hereinafter as "claims") arising from and relating to the ROUTINE MAINTENANCE (or lack thereof) of Lewis Avenue from 14th Street to Belvidere Street as heretofore described.
5. The COUNTY agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the CITY, its elected officials and its duly appointed officials, agents, employees and representatives from and against any and all claims, suits, settlements, actions, losses, expenses, damages, injuries,

judgments and demands (collectively referred to hereinafter as “claims”) arising from and relating to the design, construction and CAPITAL MAINTENANCE of the INTERIM IMPROVEMENT of Lewis Avenue from 14th Street to Belvidere Street as heretofore described.

6. It is mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto that THIS AGREEMENT shall be deemed to take effect on December 1, 2016, provided the duly authorized agents of the parties hereto duly execute THIS AGREEMENT by affixing their signatures prior to December 1, 2016. In the event the date that the last authorized agent of the parties hereto affixes their signature to THIS AGREEMENT is subsequent to December 1, 2016, the effective date of THIS AGREEMENT shall then be the first day of the month which follows the date that the last authorized agent of the parties hereto affixes their signature.
7. It is mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto that THIS AGREEMENT shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois and venue shall at all times rest in Lake County Illinois, by any appropriate action at law or in equity, including any action to secure the performance of the representations, promises, covenants, agreements and obligations contained herein.
8. It is mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto that the provisions of THIS AGREEMENT are severable. If any provision of THIS AGREEMENT is for any reason held to be contrary to law, or contrary to any rule or regulation having the force and effect of law, the illegality of such provision shall not affect the remaining portions of THIS AGREEMENT.
9. It is mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto that the agreement of the parties hereto is contained herein and that THIS AGREEMENT supersedes all oral agreements and negotiations between the parties hereto relating to the subject matter hereof.
10. All notices and other communications which are required to be, or which may be, given under THIS AGREEMENT shall be in writing, and shall be delivered at the addresses set out herein below. Notice may be given by personal delivery, recognized overnight courier or by United States mail in the manner set forth below. Notice shall be deemed to have been duly given (a) if by personal delivery, on the first to occur of the date of actual receipt or refusal of delivery by any person at the intended address, (b) if by overnight courier, on the first (1st) Business Day after being delivered to a nationally-recognized overnight courier, or (c) if by mail, on the second (2nd) Business Day after being deposited in the United States mail, certified or registered mail, return receipt requested, postage prepaid, addressed as follows:

11. In the event that any action, suit, or other proceeding is instituted to remedy, prevent, or obtain relief from a breach of THIS AGREEMENT, or arising out of a breach of THIS AGREEMENT, the prevailing party shall recover from the unsuccessful party as part of the judgment all of such party's reasonable attorneys' fees and costs incurred in each and every such action, suit, or other proceeding.
12. It is mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto that any alterations, amendments, deletions or waivers of any provision of THIS AGREEMENT shall be valid only when expressed in writing and duly executed by the parties hereto.
13. THIS AGREEMENT shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto, their successors and assigns. No party hereto shall assign, transfer, sell, grant, convey, deed, cede or otherwise give over, in any manner or form, any of its duties, obligations and/or responsibilities as heretofore set forth in THIS AGREEMENT without first obtaining the expressed written consent and permission of the other party, except as provided for in THIS AGREEMENT.
14. THIS AGREEMENT may be executed in multiple identical counterparts, and all of said counterparts shall, individually and taken together, constitute THIS AGREEMENT. Signatures transmitted by e-mail shall have the same legal effect as an original signature.
15. Except where otherwise provided in THIS AGREEMENT, the term of THIS AGREEMENT shall be perpetual in nature and terminable only by the mutual written agreement of both of the parties hereto.

16. THIS AGREEMENT shall be considered null and void in the event that the construction contract covering the INTERIM IMPROVEMENT contemplated herein is not awarded by January 1, 2022.

(County Section No. 16-00082-08-RS)



WHEREAS, the authority to make changes to the Township Road District System is granted to the Highway Commissioner under Section 6-201.3 of the Illinois Highway Code.

The Conveyor Agrees to prepare a map of the above location and attach a copy of such location map hereto.
