- The index from the Human Rights Campaign Foundation looks at foundational policies and training in LGBTQ+ patient-centered care, services, support, employee benefits and policies, and patient and community engagement.

- A Lake County tobacco and e-cigarette store had its license suspended for two weeks after receiving multiple complaints about selling its products to minors.
- The Health Department heard sworn testimony regarding the unlawful selling of tobacco at a hearing on March 13. After the hearing, the health officer suspended Moshi's tobacco license from April 25 through May 8.
