
Plan Strategy 1-1 Support the BEAD Process — In Progress

Plan Strategy 4-2 ACP Outreach and Enrollment Campaign – *Program Ending*

- Congress has not approved additional funds for ACP by the deadline of April 30th, 2024
- The last fully funded month of the program was April 2024
- Lake County Residents will receive a partial credit of \$14 towards their internet service bill if they are still participating in the program in May 2024


