

**Summary of Significant Proposed Revisions to Lake County Board of Health  
Ordinance Article XVII – Animal/Rabies Control Fees**

- ❑ The **title** of the ordinance was changed to reflect the current title and mission of the program from “Animal/Rabies Control” to “Animal Care and Control.”
- ❑ **Section 101.1:** makes animals 9 months of age or under eligible for the reduced altered (spayed/neutered) 1 year registration fee.
- ❑ **Section 101.2:** corrects an error by raising the 1 year intact animal registration fee from the current \$40.00 to \$50.00 so that for both intact and altered animals, the 1 year fee is set at 40% of the 3 year fee.
- ❑ **Section 101.5:** moves the \$10.00 late fee for failure to register an animal within 30 days of registration from Article X to its appropriate location in the schedule of fees.
- ❑ **Section 101.7:** references the Animal Care and Control Administrative Procedures and Policies document regarding criteria for assessing the altered registration fee for certain intact animals.
- ❑ **Section 201.9:** codifies in the ordinance the stipulation that a transportation fee of \$45.00 will be assessed for *each vehicle* used to transport animals (which is the current policy of program).
- ❑ **Section 301.1:** raises the fee to relinquish an adoptable animal from \$20.00 to \$25.00, which is the fee that Orphans of the Storm currently assesses our department to receive the animals.
- ❑ **Section 1401:** moves the violation fees from Article X to their appropriate location in Article XVII, the schedule of fees.
