This proposal is for the processing of lidar data previously acquired in 2007. Coverage includes 487 square miles of Lake County, Illinois. USGS funding of \$161,268.59 is requested, with no matching funds available. The proposed project period is from February 1, 2010 through September 30, 2010.

The proposed project is entirely contained in a priority coastal area and is an AOI of moderate size. The project has a high likelihood of being immediately relevant and meaningful as demonstrated by 17 letters of support from the villages within the county and the USACE. The county appears to have resources to manage the project. There is no cost to the USGS for acquisition of the primary lidar data as the data already exists. Project costs are for processing only. The two Principal Investigators listed appear to have nearly 20 years each doing this type of work within Lake County. Specific previous projects include eight years of work with Merrick for planimetric data and management of county wide orthophotography projects.

There is some limited discussion of accuracy requirements being difficult to meet. The panel believes that the subcontractor (Merrick) probably has a reasonable understanding of the requirement and, therefore, the risk is low to moderate. The panel believes that the resultant data will substantively meet base USGS specifications but feels that further discussion is warranted. The majority of the technical proposal is related to cost rather than technical details. There is no discussion of risk, QA, reviews, or reporting.

The panel recommends this proposal for funding.
