AGREEMENT

This Agreement entered into this _____ day of _____, 20____A.D, by and between the STATE OF ILLINOIS, acting by and through its DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION hereinafter called the STATE, and the COUNTY OF LAKE of the State of Illinois, hereinafter called the COUNTY.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the STATE in order to facilitate the free flow of traffic and insure safety to the motoring public, is desirous of jurisdictionally transferring Cedar Lake Road, (Cedar Lake Road, STATE Section 65-RS-1, C-91-334-11); and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY is willing to assume jurisdiction and maintenance of Cedar Lake Road; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY is desirous of said improvement in that same will be of immediate benefit to the COUNTY residents and permanent in nature;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:

 The STATE and the COUNTY have agreed to the jurisdictional transfer of the portion of highway described in the Local Agency – State Jurisdictional Transfer document attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and made a part hereof

- It is mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto that upon occurrence of the
 Jurisdictional Transfer and receipt of an invoice from the COUNTY, the STATE will
 reimburse the COUNTY \$300,000 for assuming jurisdiction and maintenance of Cedar
 Lake Road.
- 3. The STATE agrees that upon execution of this agreement and receipt of an invoice from the COUNTY, the STATE will pay to the COUNTY in a lump sum amount, an amount equal to 100% of its obligation incurred under this agreement.
- 4. All projects for the construction of fixed works which are financed in whole or in part with funds provided by this Agreement shall be subject to the Prevailing Wage Act (820 ILCS 130/0.01 et seq.) unless the provisions of that Act exempt its application.
- The COUNTY agrees to comply with all applicable Executive Orders and Federal
 Highway Acts pursuant to the Equal Employment Opportunity and non-discrimination
 regulations required by the Illinois Department of Transportation.
- 6. The COUNTY, subrecipient or subcontractor shall not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, or sex in the performance of this contract. The COUNTY shall carry out applicable requirements of 49 CFR, Part 26, in the award and administration of STATE assisted contracts. Failure by the COUNTY to carry out these requirements is a material breach of this Agreement, which may result in the termination of this Agreement or such other remedy as the STATE deems appropriate.

Obligations of the STATE and COUNTY will cease immediately without penalty or further payment being required if, in any fiscal year, the Illinois General Assembly or Federal funding source fails to appropriate or otherwise make available funds for this contract.

This AGREEMENT and the covenants contained herein shall be null and void in the event the contract covering the construction work contemplated herein is not awarded within the three years subsequent to execution of the agreement.

This Agreement shall be binding upon and to the benefit of the parties hereto, their successors and assigns.


