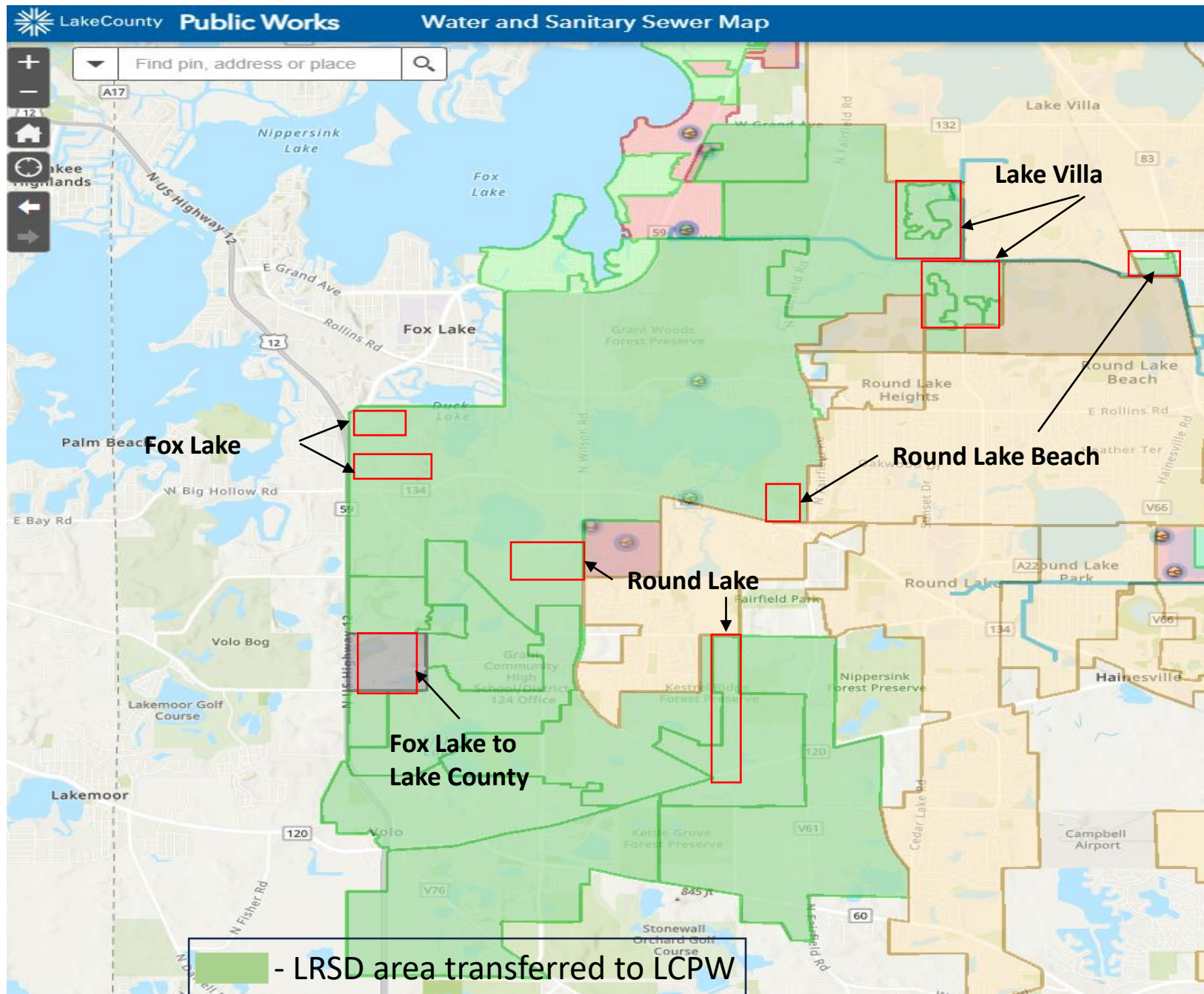

History of LRSD Overlap

- In 2018, the overlap of the LRSD collection system with selected municipalities was identified and discussed.
- In 2019 the Restated and Amended Agreement with LRSD led to the dissolution of the district.
- The LRSD collection system in portions Fox lake, Round Lake, Round Lake Beach, and Lake Villa fall within these village's municipal boundaries and feed directly into their collection systems
- 15% of the former LRSD collection system is within municipal boundaries

Current Status

- June 2023 – LRSD disestablishment actions were completed, leading to further discussion on overlap realignment with these municipalities
- Further realignment could streamline billing in some of the overlap areas
- Policy on realignment was drafted and reviewed by SAO
- Some existing Intergovernmental Agreements may be revised pending outcome
- Transfer of property via quit claim deed or appropriate instrument

Recommendations

- Seeking Committee's recommendations on the Policy
- Next Steps pending approval:
 - a) Present Policy to Northwest Facility Planning Area Committees for their awareness
 - b) Send Policy to impacted municipalities
 - c) Return Policy to committees for action and County Board Approval
