
County Strategic Plan Goal: Promote a Sustainable Environment

75% of all construction and demolition debris is recycled for covered projects in unincorporated areas of Lake County.

PB&D FY18 Highlights

- Construction & Demolition Debris Diversion
 - 88% diversion rate achieved
 - 3700 tons of waste diverted from landfill
- Vehicle Miles Saved

 - Saved 74,036 vehicle miles
 - Efficient Staff Routing
- Collaborative procurement
 - Solar Energy
