Joint resolution authorizing an increase in the budgeted number of full-time equivalent positions in the Chief County Assessment Office from 20 to 22.

- The Chief County Assessment Office has realized a 50% increase in case filings for 2011 as compared to 2010.
- It is anticipated that 2012 case filings will continue to trend significantly higher than previous years.
- In order to respond to the increased work load, the Chief County Assessment Office requests two additional Senior Clerk positions (pay grade 6) be hired and paid an annual salary of \$27,241.
- The total cost for the two positions including fringes benefits will be \$31,570 for the remainder of the fiscal year.
