The Lake County Stormwater Management Commission and Park City Mayor, Steve Pannell, invite you to attend a groundbreaking event to mark the start of construction on the Park City Flood Mitigation Storm Sewer Project on Wednesday, June 21 at 11 a.m.

This long-awaited historic infrastructure improvement project will provide flood damage reduction benefits to more than 800 properties. Grant funds will be utilized for the construction of large box culverts and storm sewer system upgrades within Park City, extending from Illinois Route 120 south to the Greenbelt Forest Preserve. Funding will also be used for modifications and the replacement of the stormwater system restrictor plate at the Casimir Pulaski Drive culvert.

Come meet the Lake County Stormwater Management Commission (SMC) team who will lead the way, along with Mayor Pannell, Lake County Board members, and state and legislators who tirelessly advocated for project funding in collaboration with SMC.
