Purchasing Diversity Initiative



- Reminder: Lake County cannot award public procurements based on minority preferences
- Goals of the Lake County Purchasing Diversity Initiative:
 - Increase the number of diverse and disadvantaged suppliers that are registered to do business with Lake County
 - Ensure that diverse and disadvantaged suppliers are aware of resources available to them to become qualified to compete for Lake County procurements (e.g., insurance and bonding requirements, minority certification, general and subcontracting opportunities, etc.)
 - Encourage diverse and disadvantaged suppliers' participation as subcontractors
 - Track and report on metrics to measure success

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Doing Businesswith Lake County


Register at doingbusiness.lakecountyil.gov

Submit bids/proposals/quotes for your products and services. Purchasing will review and evaluate and make a recommendation. If selected, enter into a contract with the County.

Issue invoices for goods and services; the County will make payment within 30 days from the date the invoice was approved.

Doing Business with Lake County

- 75 -100 Bids and Requests for Proposals issued annually
- 25% of procurement is for construction services
- Engage local and minority contractors
- Register for bid opportunities
